Two and the cup

The story of Christ and the sons of Zebadee is a prophecy of the end times.

The mother of Zebedees children came to Christ to ask they sit on his right and his left.

Matt 20:20 Then came to him the mother of Zebedees children with her sons, worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him.

Matt 20:21 And he said unto her, What wilt thou? She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom.

Then Christ asks themare they able to drink of the cup He is to drink of?

Matt 20: 22 But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

They reppond they are able to drink of that cup that Christ drink of and He responds to them they will indeed drink of that cup.

Matt 20:23 And **he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup,** and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared of my Father.

Matt 20:24 And when the ten heard it, they were moved with **indignation against the two brethren.**

Christ affirms they will indeed drink of His cup.

The cup that Christ is to drink of is His blood made to wine through His martyrdom.

Christ being the first grape blood shed for the covenant wine.

Mark 14:23 And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them: and they all drank of it.

They drank of the cup of the covenant of wine of Christs blood shed.

This cup is filled with His blood as wine to be drank.. the grape of the vineyard.

Luke 22:20 Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood**, which is shed for you.

The prophesy refers to the grapes before the new covenant.

Jeremiah 31:29 In those days they shall say no more, The fathers have eaten a sour grape, and the children's teeth are set on edge.

30 But every one shall die for his own iniquity: every man that eateth the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge.

31 Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

This cup of the wine of Christs blood for the new covenant came by the martyrdom of Christ.

The prophetic cup of the wine being blood shed and the two drinking from that cup is seen in the two brothers.

Here is the two prophets.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The two brothers.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because **these two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

Two prophets are killed where Christ was killed.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

The blood is shed as martyrdom just like Christs wine.

The Two are resurrected after three and half days just like Christ was in the cup of the new covenant.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

The two ascend just like Christ did.

Rev 11:12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the two sons of zebedee asking to drink of the cup of Christ that is fulfilled by two prophets in the end drinking from the cup of Christs wine being martyred.
