

Golden cup

The prophesy and stories of the past are foretold of what is to come with the golden cup in the hand of king of babylon and of Jerusalem the harlot..

Jeremiah 25:13 And I will bring upon that land all my words which I have pronounced against it, even all that is written in this book, which **Jeremiah hath prophesied against all the nations.**

Jer 25:14 For many nations and great kings shall serve themselves of them also: and I will recompense them according to their deeds, and according to the works of their own hands.

Jer 25:15 For thus saith the Lord God of Israel unto me; Take **the wine cup of this fury at my hand**, and **cause all the nations**, to whom I send thee, **to drink it.**

Jer 25:16 And they shall drink, and be moved, and be mad, because of the sword that I will send among them.

Jer 25:17 Then took **I the cup at the Lord's hand, and made all the nations to drink**, unto whom the Lord had sent me:

The prophet was sent to prophesy to the nations to make them drink of the golden cup.

Jeremiah 51:7 **Babylon hath been a golden cup in the Lord's hand**, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

The nations were trample by the king of babylon and served the king of babylon.

Jeremiah 25:18 To wit, Jerusalem, and the cities of Judah, and the kings thereof, and the princes thereof, to make them a desolation, an astonishment, an hissing, and a curse; as it is this day;

Jer 25:19 Pharaoh **king of Egypt**, and his servants, and his princes, and all his people;

Jer 25:20 And all the mingled people, and **all the kings of the land of Uz**, and **all the kings of the land of the Philistines**, and Ashkelon, and Azzah, and Ekron, and the remnant of Ashdod,

Jer 25:21 Edom, and Moab, and the children of Ammon,

Jer 25:22 And **all the kings of Tyrus**, and **all the kings of Zidon**, and **the kings of the isles** which are beyond the sea,

Jer 25:23 Dedan, and Tema, and Buz, and all that are in the utmost corners,

Jer 25:24 And **all the kings of Arabia**, and all the kings of the mingled people that dwell in the desert,

Jer 25:25 And **all the kings of Zimri**, and all **the kings** of Elam, and all **the kings** of the Medes,

Jer 25:26 And **all the kings of the north**, far and near, one with another, and all the kingdoms of the world, which are upon the face of the earth: and the king of Sheshach **shall drink after them**.

Jer 25:27 Therefore thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel; **Drink ye, and be drunken**, and spue, and fall, and rise no more, because of the sword which I will send among you.

The nations and thier kings drank of the cup of the wrath of the Lord using the king of babylon.

Isaiah 51:17 Awake, awake, stand up, **O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the Lord the cup of his fury**; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, and wrung them out.

The cup of the Lords fury and wrath.

Psalm 75:8 For **in the hand of the Lord there is a cup**, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same: but the dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring them out, and drink them.

Jerusalem the harlot is drinking with the kings of the earth.

Rev 17:2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

Jerusalem has the golden cup in her hand.

Rev 17:4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, **having a golden cup in her hand** full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

Jerusalem will have prophets prophesying making all the nations drinking from the golden cup just like Jerusalem had Jeremiah prophesying to the nations.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Jerusalem is where the Lord was crucified.

Rev 11:8 and their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, **where also our Lord was crucified**.

The nations will serve the prophetic king of babylon.

Rev 17:17 For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

Rev 17:18 And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth.

Prophesying to the kings of the earth and nations that they will drink from the golden cup.

Revelation 10:11 And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

The cup of indignation of wrath

Rev 14:8 And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because **she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.**

Rev 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

Rev 14:10 **The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God,** which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

The prophetic foreshadow of the end times is seen in the king of babylon and the prophet prophesyign to the kings of the earth that they will drink from the golden cup is foreshadow of the end times prophesy.
