

Honey and lion.

The story of Samson the prophet pulling honey out of the lions belly is a prophetic foreshadow of end times.

Judges 14:8 And after a time he returned to take her, and he turned aside to see the carcase of the lion: and, behold, there **was a swarm of bees and honey in the carcase of the lion.**

Judges 14:9 And **he took thereof in his hands, and went on eating**, and came to his father and mother, and **he gave them, and they did eat**: but he told not them that he had taken the honey out of the carcase of the lion.

The prophet took from the belly of the lion the honey and ate and began to feed others the honey.

This is prophetic foreshadow of the end.

The lion of Judah opens the book.

Rev 5:3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

Rev 5:4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: **behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah**, the Root of David, **hath prevailed to open the book**, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Out of the belly of the Lion of Judah the word proceeds forth.

John 7:37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.**

John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, **out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.**

Christ says to drink what flows out of his belly.

That book is the prophesy that is honey flowing out of the belly of the lion.

Ezek 3:1 Moreover he said unto me, Son of man, eat that thou findest; **eat this roll, and go speak unto the house of Israel.**

Ezek 3: 2 So I opened my mouth, and **he caused me to eat that roll.**

Ezek 3:3 And he said unto me, Son of man, **cause thy belly to eat**, and fill thy bowels with this roll that I give thee. Then did I eat it; and **it was in my mouth as honey for sweetness.**

Ezek 3:4 And he said unto me, Son of man, go, get thee unto the house of Israel, and **speak with my words unto them.**

The book that the lion of Judah opened will be prophesied as its unsealed.

Rev 10:8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

Rev 10:9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, **Give me the little book.** And he said unto me, **Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.**

Rev 10:10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; **and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.**

Rev 10:11 And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

The little book is eaten and prophesied to the earth.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

This is the prophet eating the honey from the lions belly.

The story of Samson eating the honey from the lions belly and feeding it to others is the prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy.
