The stories in the bible gives a prophetic forshadow of the prophecy of the end times.

The foreshadow of the bull fighter who is a faithful martyr.

Two accounts testify of two prophets who are bull fighters.

Moses fights and slays a bull.

Exodus 32:19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that **he saw the calf**, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

Exodus 32:20 And **he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder**, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it.

Moses slayed the bull Moloch.

Like wise Elijah was also fighting and slaying bulls.

Elijah with the prophets of baal who worshiped the bull also testifies he was a bull fighter.

1 Kings 18:22 **Then said Elijah unto the people**, I, even I only, remain a prophet of the Lord; but Baal's prophets are four hundred and fifty men.

1 Kings 18:23 **Let them therefore give us two bullocks**; and let them choose one bullock for themselves, and cut it in pieces, and lay it on wood, and put no fire under: and **I will dress the other bullock**, and lay it on wood, and put no fire under:

Elijah slayed the bull.

The prophets of baal are worshiping moloch which is baals representative.

1 Kings 18:26 And they took **the bullock which was given them, and they dressed it, and called on the name of Baal** from morning even until noon, saying, **O Baal, hear us**. But there was no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made.

The prophets of baals are bulls themselves and were slain.

1 Kings 18:40 And Elijah said unto them, **Take the prophets of Baal**; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and **Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there**.

So we see Elijah was fighting moloch baal worshipers and slaying a bull and the bulls.



Christ said the enemies of God surrounding Him were bulls in His quoted Psalm 22 about His fulfillment on the cross.

Psalm 22:1 My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

Psalm 22:7 All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,

Psalm 22:8 He trusted on the Lord that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.

Psalm 22:12 **Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round.**

We see that these men are likened to bulls of bashan.

Again in the prophecy of the end times we see the wicked being killed regarded as bulls.

Isa 34:6 **The sword of the Lord is filled with blood**, it is made fat with fatness, and with the blood of lambs and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams: for **the Lord hath a sacrifice in Bozrah**, and a great slaughter in the land of Idumea.

Isa 34:7 And the unicorns shall come down with them, and **the bullocks with the bulls**; and their land shall be soaked with blood, and their dust made fat with fatness.

Isa34:8 For it is the day of the Lord's vengeance, and the year of recompences for the controversy of Zion.

The bulls and bullocks are the slaying of these men..

This account is also given by Ezekiel of the end times when the birds are called to eat their remains.

Ezek 39:17 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord God; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a **great sacrifice** upon the mountains of Israel, that **ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.**

Ezek 39:18 **Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth**, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, **of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.**

Ezek 39:19 And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

Ezek 39:20 Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, **with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord God.**

We see that the account of the men who fight against Christ on His return are accounted as a sacrifice of bulls.

This is the same account of the return of Christ and the slaying of the bulls.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

Rev 19:18 **That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men,** and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Rev 19:19 And **I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him** that sat on the horse, and against his army.

These are bulls surrounding to fight Christ again that will be slain.

The marduk worship of Babylon was Baal and his dragon.

Bel is baal and is seen in the bible prophesy.

Jer 51:44 And **I will punish Bel in Babylon,** and I will bring forth out of his mouth that which he hath swallowed up: and the nations shall not flow together any more unto him: yea, the wall of Babylon shall fall.

It is bel or baal who will bow down before the Lord.

Isa 46:1 **Bel boweth down,** Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages were heavy loaden; they are a burden to the weary beast.

Bels image will be destroyed

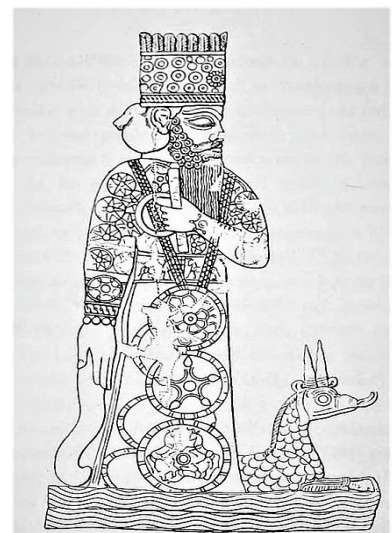
Jer 50:2 Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, and conceal not: say, **Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces;** her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

Bel and Maroduk is the word here in the prophesy and its related to the god of babylon.

The **Statue of Marduk**, also known as the **Statue of Bêl** (Bêl, meaning "lord", being a common designation for **Marduk was the physical representation of the god Marduk**, the patron deity of the ancient city of Babylon,

Marduk "calf of the sun; solar calf "

; Hebrew: מֵרֹדַךְ Modern: Merōdaḵ, Tiberian: Mərōdaḵ) is a god from ancient Mesopotamia and patron deity of Babylon who eventually rose to power in the 1st millennium BC. In Babylon, Marduk was worshipped in the temple Esagila. His symbol is the spade and **he is associated with the Mušḫuššu**



Marduk is represented as the Solar Calf or the sun Bull.

This is marduk and his dragon called mushussu.

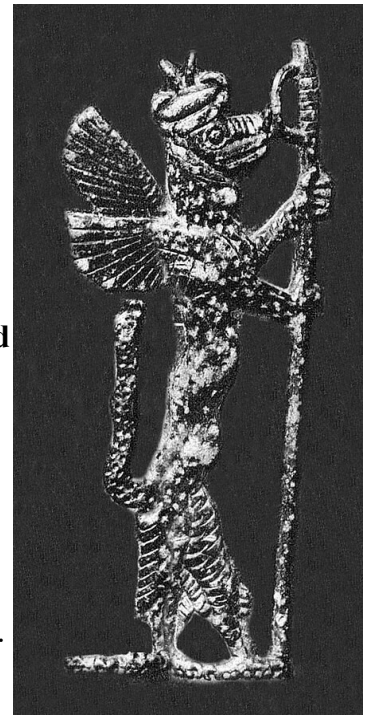
This is satan the dragon of old.

Rev 12:9 And **the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan**, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

The marduk and musshushu is baal and the dragon

The bull and the dragon..

This is what the prophets of baal were worshiping in the image of baal.



This is what is likeness in the end times image of the beast as well.

The king of babylon is representative of marduk. The image of the king of babylon is baal.

The image of the beast is baal..

They make the image of the beast from prophetic babylon..

Rev 13:14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, **that they should make an image to the beast**, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

They worship the dragon.

Rev 13:4 And **they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast**: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

This is Marduk and the dragon, Baal(bel) and the dragon, the beast and the dragon, king of babylon and the dragon.

The Faithful Martyr Anitpas was killed by the bull worshipers and fought the bull.

Rev 2:12 And to the angel of **the church in Pergamos** write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

13 I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even **where Satan's seat is**: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days **wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth**.

Antipas was slain at the seat of satan as a faithful martyr.

Antipas of Pergamos was said to be burned alive inside a brass moloch bull.

“The traditional accounts go on to say Antipas was martyred during the reign of Nero (54-68) or Domitian, **by burning in a brazen bull-shaped altar** for casting out demons worshipped by the local population”

So we have the account of two prophets fighting the bull baal worship and slaying bulls foreshadowing the end.



We have baal worship of king of babylon and his dragon and his image of the baal being fought against by two prophets.

We have a faithful martyr being killed by bull worshipers.

This end times fight against the image of the beast of the king of prophetic babylon and being killed by the beast who is marduk the bull and his bulls following him is seen in the prophecy.

Two prophets risen to fight the bull..

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Two prophets...

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these **two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

Any bull trying to fight them must be killed.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and **if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.**

The beast king of babylon kills the faithful martyrs like antipas as he is Marduk the bull.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and **shall overcome them, and kill them.**

Then the faithful bullfighters are risen to fight the bulls again and slay the prophets of baal.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and **they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.**

The bulls of bashan will be brought to meggido to brook of Kishon at the base of MT carmel

1 Kings 18:40 And Elijah said unto them, **Take the prophets of Baal;** let not one of them escape. And they took them: and **Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there.**

This is why its said he will gather them to valley of meggido which is at the base of mount carmel.

Rev 16:16 And **he gathered them together** into a place called in the Hebrew tongue **Armageddon.**

The river will be turned to blood with the bulls blood.

The stories of the two prophets Moses and Elijah slaying and fighting bulls are prophetic foreshadows of the end times prophecy.

The bull fighter has arrived.
