

Milk and honey

The story of Joshua and Caleb giving the promise of the land that it will flow with milk and honey is a prophetic foreshadow of the end times.

Numbers 14:6-And **Joshua the son of Nun**, and **Caleb the son of Jephunneh**, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes:

Numbers 14: 7 And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land.

Numbers 14:8 If the Lord delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land **which floweth with milk and honey.**

Numbers 14:9 Only rebel not ye against the Lord, neither fear ye the people of the land; for they are bread for us: their defence is departed from them, and the Lord is with us: fear them not.

This is two testifying of the land flowing with milk and honey.

The promise given from two prophets Moses and Aaron to the children of Israel.

Deut 26:8 And the Lord brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terribleness, and with signs, and with wonders:

Deut 26:9 And he hath brought us into this place, and hath given us this land, even **a land that floweth with milk and honey.**

Two prophets testifying of the land flowing with milk and honey.

The Milk is the law of Moses.

1 Peter 2:1 Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,

1 Peter 2:2 As **newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word**, that ye may grow thereby:

Those who should be teachers by now are still in need of the law of Moses to understand how to teach.

Heb 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, **ye have need that one teach you again** which be **the first principles of the oracles of God**; and are become such as **have need of milk**, and not of strong meat.

What oracles of God need to be taught again that is milk?

Rom 3:1 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit is there of circumcision?

Rom 3:2 Much every way: chiefly, because that unto **them were committed the oracles of God.**

The law of Moses are the first principles of the Oracles of God which one should teach you.

The honey is the prophesy.

Ezek 3:1 Moreover he said unto me, Son of man, eat that thou findest; eat this roll, and go speak unto the house of Israel.

Ezek 3:2 So I opened my mouth, and he caused me to eat that roll.

Ezek 3:3 And he said unto me, Son of man, cause thy belly to eat, and fill thy bowels with this roll that I give thee. Then did I eat it; and it was **in my mouth as honey for sweetness.**

Ezek 3:4 And he said unto me, Son of man, go, get thee unto the house of Israel, and speak with my words unto them.

The prophesy is the honey.

Rev 10:9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall **be in thy mouth sweet as honey.**

Rev 10:10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and **it was in my mouth sweet as honey:** and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

Rev 10:11 And he said unto me, **Thou must prophesy again** before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

The promise of the promise land to flow with milk and honey is given because in the end times Jerusalem will flow with the law and the prophets. This is the flowing of the milk and honey promised.

Numbers 14:8 If the Lord delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land **which floweth with milk and honey.**

Two testifying of the law and the prophets from Jerusalem is the prophetic foreshadow.

The spouse should have a mouth that flows with milk and honey.

Song of Solomon 4:11 **Thy lips, O my spouse, drop as the honeycomb: honey and milk are under thy tongue;** and the smell of thy garments is like the smell of Lebanon.

The promise from two prophets that the land will flow with milk and honey.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The law is the fire proceeding from the mouth.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth,** and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

The two prophets.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these **two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

The two prophets prophesying for 1260 days the law and the prophets is the land of israel flowing with milk and honey promised.

The story of Caleb and Joshua, the two testifying of the land flowing with milk and honey is the prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy of two prophets prophesying the law and the prophets with the law and the prophets flowing from the mouths of two prophets in the end times.
