

Do not enter

The story of the book of numbers has a prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

The book of numbers gives an account of the people of God in the wilderness being told they cant dwell in the land of israel but only two are permitted to go in based on the number of days.

Numbers 14: 30 **Doubtless ye shall not come into the land**, concerning which I sware to make you dwell therein, save **Caleb** the son of Jephunneh, and **Joshua** the son of Nun.

We see that first two men were set apart from the people of God in the wilderness who could enter.

Numbers 14:31 But your little ones, which ye said should be a prey, them will I bring in, and they shall know the land which ye have despised.

Numbers 14:32 But as for you, your carcasses, they shall fall in this wilderness.

We see that the people of God were told theyd stay in the wilderness a certain alotment of time.

Numbers 14:33 And **your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years**, and bear your whoredoms, until your carcasses be wasted in the wilderness.

We see the time alotment of time was reflective of the number of days which the land was searched out a day for each year.

Numbers 14:34 **After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year**, shall ye bear your iniquities, even forty years, and ye shall know my breach of promise.

Numbers 14:35 I the Lord have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: in this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

Numbers 14:36 And the men, which Moses sent to search the land, who returned, and made all the congregation to murmur against him, by bringing up a slander upon the land,

We see that those gathered against the Lord recieved the plagues.

Numbers 14:37 Even those men that did bring up the evil report upon the land, **died by the plague before the Lord.**

Two who went to search out the land lived still.

Numbers 14:38 But **Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh**, which were of the men that went to search the land, **lived still.**

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the prophesy of the end times.

Looking to how this is foreshadow of the end times we look to where Christ tells His people to not enter back into the promise land in the end times after they exodus in wilderness.

Luke 21:20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

Luke 21:21 Then **let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains;** and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and **let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.**

We see the clear warning of Christ that people that are in the wilderness who left are not to enter the promise land.

We know that the people are in the wilderness a certain numbered amount of days.

Rev 12:6 And **the woman fled into the wilderness**, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there **a thousand two hundred and threescore days.**

They are in the wilderness for 1260 days, thousand two hundred and threescore days or forty two months which is 3.5 years.

We know that the Lord sends two into the land to search out the land.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

The two are sent into the land for 1260 days, forty two months, a thousand two hundred and threescore days or 3.5 years.

This is very specific for a day for each year that the two searched out the land and it continues to be fulfilling through these number of days.

Numbers 14:34 **After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year**, shall ye bear your iniquities, even forty years, and ye shall know my breach of promise.

Just as the number of days where searched out the land the people were in wilderness 3.5 years for each day that two searched out the land of Sheol.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall **see their dead bodies three days and an half**, and shall **not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.**

We see that for 3.5 days the dead bodies of two are laying on the ground as they search out the land of Sheol.

Just as Caleb and Joshua searched out the land they shall live it will be done in the end times.

Numbers 14:38 But **Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh**, which were of the men that went to search the land, **lived still**.

The two prophets who search out the land of Sheol come back to life and live.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet;** and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Two entering into sheol for the 3.5 days just like Christ.

After the 3.5 days searching out the land of sheol they live still just as Caleb and Joshua.

Those in the world who strive against the Lord during the time of those 3.5 years in the wilderness will also see plagues just like foreshadowed.

Numbers 14:36 And the men, which Moses sent to search the land, who returned, and made all the congregation to murmur against him, by bringing up a slander upon the land,

Numbers 14:37 Even those men that did bring up the evil report upon the land, **died by the plague before the Lord**.

We see that the two are prophesying plagues during that 3.5 years of those gathered in wilderness.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will**.

The story in the account of the number of days in the wilderness with Caleb and Joshua searching out the land is a prophetic foreshadow of the end times.

The land of promise is not to be entered during those 42 months, 1260 days, a thousand two hundred and threescore days or 3.5 years.

This is a clear prophetic warning to do not enter.

Do not enter.
