

Two and twelve

The end times prophesy is foreshadowed in events of the old testament with the twelve tribes.

Two prophets before they die are prophesying to the twelve tribes.

We see the law testifying of the prophesy of the end times through having two witnesses testifying of this account.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses**, or at the mouth of three witnesses, **shall the matter be established.**

First we see the prophet Jacob before He dies he begins to prophesy to the twelve tribes.

Genesis 49:49 And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, Gather yourselves together, **that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the last days.**

Jacob begins to prophesy to the twelve tribes about what will happen in the latter days.

Genesis 49:2 **Gather yourselves together, and hear**, ye sons of Jacob; and hearken unto Israel your father.

Jacob foreshadows the gathering together of the tribes by telling them to gather together to hear.

Genesis 49:3 **Reuben, thou art my firstborn**, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

Jacob then begins to prophesy to all the twelve tribes.

Gen 49:5 **Simeon and Levi** are brethren; instruments of cruelty are in their habitations.

He continues on through all the twelve tribes into the latter verses of chapter.

Gen 49:19 **Gad**, a troop shall overcome him: but he shall overcome at the last.

Gen 49:20 Out of **Asher** his bread shall be fat, and he shall yield royal dainties.

Gen 49:21 **Naphtali** is a hind let loose: he giveth goodly words.

Gen 49:22 **Joseph** is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well; whose branches run over the wall:

Gen 49:23 The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him:

Gen 49:24 But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the mighty God of Jacob; (from thence is the shepherd, the **stone of Israel:**)

He then finishes in discussion of the stone of Israel which will be covered prophetically.

He finishes with the last son prophesying to all the twelve tribes and explains how about to die.

Gen 49:27 **Benjamin** shall ravin as a wolf: in the morning he shall devour the prey, and at night he shall divide the spoil.

Gen 49:28 **All these are the twelve tribes of Israel:** and this is it that their father spake unto them, and blessed them; every one according to his blessing he blessed them.

Gen 49:29 And he charged them, and said unto them, **I am to be gathered unto my people: bury me** with my fathers in the cave that is in the field of Ephron the Hittite,

Jacob dies after prophesying about his grave which will become significant later prophetically.

Genesis 49:33 And when **Jacob had made an end of commanding his sons**, he gathered up his feet into the bed, and yielded up the ghost, and was gathered unto his people.

This is the first witness of a prophet prophesying to the twelve tribes before he dies and making known details about his grave before he dies and talking about a stone of Israel.

The second witness is the prophet Moses.

Deut 33:33 And this is the blessing, wherewith Moses the man of God blessed the children of Israel **before his death**

Moses before he dies takes the twelve tribes on an Exodus and prophesies to the twelve tribes.

Deut 33:4 Moses commanded us a law, even the inheritance of the congregation of Jacob.

Deut 33:5 And he was king in Jeshurun, **when the heads of the people and the tribes of Israel were gathered together.**

Deut 33:6 Let **Reuben live**, and not die; and let not his men be few.

Deut 33:7 And this is **the blessing of Judah:** and he said, Hear, Lord, the voice of Judah, and bring him unto his people: let his hands be sufficient for him; and be thou an help to him from his enemies.

Deut 33:8 And **of Levi he said**, Let thy Thummim and thy Urim be with thy holy one, whom thou didst prove at Massah, and with whom thou didst strive at the waters of Meribah;

Deut 33:12 And **of Benjamin** he said, The beloved of the Lord shall dwell in safety by him; and the Lord shall cover him all the day long, and he shall dwell between his shoulders.

Deut 33:13 **And of Joseph** he said, Blessed of the Lord be his land, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that coucheth beneath,

Moses finishes prophesying to the twelve tribes and then he dies.

Deut 34:4 And the Lord said unto him, This is the land which I swore unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, saying, I will give it unto thy seed: I have caused thee to see it with thine eyes, but thou shalt not go over thither.

Deut 34:5 So **Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab**, according to the word of the Lord.

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophecy found in the two witnesses of two prophets prophesying to the twelve tribes of both Jacob and Moses.

The end times prophesy has the two prophets and two witnesses.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The two prophets.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because **these two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

These two prophets prophesy the Exodus into the wilderness.

Rev 11:14 And to **the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness**, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

These two prophets gather the twelve tribes and prophesy to the twelve tribes which is seen in the book of revelation sealing of the tribes.

Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.

Rev 7:5 Of the **tribe of Juda** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Reuben** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Gad** were sealed twelve thousand.

Rev 7:6 Of the **tribe of Aser** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Nephthalim** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Manasses** were sealed twelve thousand.

Rev 7:7 Of the **tribe of Simeon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Levi** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Issachar** were sealed twelve thousand.

Rev 7:8 Of the **tribe of Zabulon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Joseph** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Benjamin** were sealed twelve thousand.

These two prophets prophesy to the twelve tribes before they die.

Rev 11:7 And **when they shall have finished their testimony**, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and **shall overcome them, and kill them**.

The two prophets prophesy of their grave just like Jacob.

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall **see their dead bodies** three days and an half, and **shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.**

These two prophets prophesy of the stone of Israel for all the tribes.

Rev 11:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him **a white stone, and in the stone a new name written**, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

This is the stone of Israel on the banner that will gather the tribes of Israel for the latter days.



The two prophets Moses and Jacob gathering and prophesying to the twelve tribes while giving details of their grave before they die and sharing about the stone of Israel are all prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

Two and twelve
