

The plough

The prophesy of the end times is found in the parable of the putting hand to the plough.

FCChrist begins to talk about a contrast of those who are dead are going to bury their dead but those who are to go preach the kingdom of God.

Luke 9:60 Jesus said unto him, **Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.**

Then other say they will follow but they first want to go back to thier house and deal with matters.

Luke 6:61 And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but **let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.**

Christ makes it clear that those who turn back and dont continue on ploughing are not fit.

Luke 6:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

This is is all prophetic end times prophesy in this parable.

The dead buring the dead. Those who do not come to the call to the gathering for the end times with the remnant are going to be burying their dead from the plagues and wrath.

Rev 6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

Those who come to the gathering are preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God to gather the kingdom to welcome the King like how they did with King David.

Here is the kingdom of God warriors gathering to welcome David to be their King.

1 Chronicles 12:37 And on the other side of Jordan, of the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and of the half tribe of Manasseh, with **all manner of instruments of war for the battle, an hundred and twenty thousand.**

Note the number of the armies is 120,000

1 Chronicles 12:38 **All these men of war**, that could keep rank, came with a perfect heart to Hebron, **to make David king over all Israel: and all the rest also of Israel were of one heart to make David king.**

This account is the gathering of the numbers of ranks of soldiers of the tribes of israel together to call on david to be king the other account of this is found.

2 Samuel 5:1 **Then came all the tribes of Israel to David** unto Hebron, and spake, saying, Behold, we are thy bone and thy flesh.

2 Samuel 5:2 Also in time past, when Saul was king over us, thou wast he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and the Lord said to thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be a captain over Israel.

1 Samuel 5:3 **So all the elders of Israel came to the king** to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the Lord: and **they anointed David king over Israel.**

This is very important to note that we see the soldiers ranks of Israel at 120,000, the elders of Israel and the others of Israel gathered together to have David be their king over them.

This is the gathering of the kingdom of God on earth that is found in the end times gospel of kingdom to all the earth.

We see the lost tribes all gathered together in ranks of their armies in preparation to call on Christ to be their King over Israel.

Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an **hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.**

Note that the number of the armies of the tribes is 144,000.

The gathering of the lost tribes and all of Israel, remnant and elders occurs for the Exodus then the wrath is poured out on the earth, this is the gospel of the kingdom being preached to all the earth that the kingdom is being restored in the Kingdom of Israel

The gospel of the kingdom of Israel being shared throughout all the earth as a witness is seen in foreshadow of the first pentecost.

Acts 1:6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, **wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?**

Acts 1:7 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and **ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.**

This is where you see the gospel of the kingdom of Israel being restored being preached to all the world as a witness just like the first pentecost and then the wrath comes.

Matt 24:14 And this **gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world** for a witness unto all nations; and **then shall the end come.**

After the gathering the end shall come, this occurs then the wrath is poured out and the dead will bury their dead who dont come.

The end times prophesy of people going to go back to thier homes first from the parable.

Luke 6:61 And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but **let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.**

At the gathering everyone is to exodus together and flee into the wilderness united.

Matt 24:16 Then let them which be in Judaea **flee into the mountains:**

Matt 24:17 Let him which is on the housetop **not come down to take any thing out of his house:**

Matt 24:18 **Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.**

Christ clearly is saying do not go back when you are called to come not even go back into your house to get your shirt, not even to go back to try to convince your family to come who isnt listening.. you are to let the dead bury the dead.

The parable also prophesy of the end times elders contained in it.

Luke 6:62 And Jesus said unto him, **No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.**

The elders we know are represented as oxen working ploughing and the twenty four elders are the twenty four oxen before the Lord in prophetic allegory.

1 Timothy 5:17 Let **the elders** that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they **who labour in the word and doctrine.**

1 Timothy 5:18 For the scripture saith, **thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn.** And, The labourer is worthy of his reward.

1 Timothy 5:19 Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

The elders are ploughing the field and treading the fields with the oxen.

The elders are called to the gathering to have Christ be King over the kingdom of Israel awaiting His descent.

1 Samuel 5:3 **So all the elders of Israel came to the king** to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the Lord: and **they anointed David king over Israel.**

So we know that elders who have begun to plough the field who look back to the world who do not come to the call to gather in the end times are not fit for the kigndom.

Luke 6:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, **having put his hand to the plough, and looking back,** is fit for the kingdom of God.

This is the end times prophesy of the gathering for the kingdom of Israel, the elders and soldiers for the end times found in the parable of ploughing.

The plough
