

Deborah and Barak

The song of Deborah has foreshadow of the prophesy of the end times in it.

The book of judges chapter 5 begins with giving two witnesses testifying of the song.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses**, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

The law requires that a matter be established by two witnesses and this begins the song with two witnesses establishign the matter.

Judges 5:1 Then sang **Deborah and Barak** the son of Abinoam on that day, saying,

Then the prophetic foreshadows continue to reffer to Edom the location of the end times Exodus and the return of Christ in the end times from Edom.

Judges 5:4 Lord, when thou wentest out of Seir, **when thou marchedst out of the field of Edom**, the earth trembled, and the heavens dropped, the clouds also dropped water.

Judges 5:5 The mountains melted from before the Lord, even that Sinai from before the Lord God of Israel.

Then the foreshadowing of the end times return of the white horses those who ride on them for judgement..

Judges 5:10 Speak, ye **that ride on white asses, ye that sit in judgment**, and walk by the way.

Then we see the kings gathered at Meggido.

Judges 5:19 **The kings came and fought**, then fought the kings of Canaan in Taanach **by the waters of Megiddo**; they took no gain of money.

We see those fighting from heaven.

Judge 5:20 **They fought from heaven**; the stars in their courses fought against Sisera.

Then we see the river of Kishon where Elijah slaid the prophets of baal and turned the river of Kishon into a river of blood is refered to in the trodding of them down.

Judges **5:21 The river of Kishon swept them away**, that ancient river, the river Kishon. O my soul, **thou hast trodden down** strength.

This is all prophetic foreshadow of the end times and this is the prophesy revealed.

The two witneeses of the end times declaring the prophesy revealing the gathering place in the field of Edom and the place of Edom as Christs return with those on white horses from heaven gathering the kings of the earth to meggido to trodden them turning the river into a river of blood.

The two witnesses prophesying is seen here in the end times as matter of the fulfillment of the law.

Revelation 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The place of Edom being revealed for the Exodus into the wilderness and fields of Edom is found.

Rev 12:6 And **the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God**, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore day

We see those in heaven on white horses for judgement is prophesied.

Rev 19:11 And **I saw heaven opened**, and behold **a white horse**; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness **he doth judge** and make war.

Those in judgement on white horses in heaven to make war.

Rev 19:14 And **the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses**, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

The kings are gathered.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the **kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered** together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

He gathers them to meggiddo to the kishon river like the prophets of baal to turn them into river of blood trodding them down.

Rev 16:16 And he **gathered them together** into a place called in the Hebrew tongue **Armageddon**.

He troddens them down. Making a river of blood just like Elijah at meggido valley in kishon river.

Rev 19:13 And he was clothed **with a vesture dipped in blood**: and his name is called The Word of God.

Trodding them down as a winepress their blood is as wine.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and **he treadeth the winepress** of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

They are killed by the armies from Edom to Meggido which is 1600 furlongs

Rev 14:20 And **the winepress was trodden** without the city, and **blood came out of the winepress**, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.

This place prepared is in the wilderness of Edom at Petra is the location where Christ descends.

Isaiah 63:1 **Who is this that cometh from Edom**, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

Isaiah 63:2 Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like **him that treadeth in the winefat?**

Isaiah 63:3 **I have trodden the winepress alone**; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; **and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.**

This is the end times prophesy revealed through the foreshadow and prophesyign of two witnesses in the book of judges by Deborah and Barak.

The two witnesses of the end are prophesying the book of Revelation found in the song of Deborah.
