

The pledge.

The story of Moses lifting the rod with banner is a foreshadow of the prophecy of the end times.

There are multiple instances where Moses would have the banner unifying the people.

The account we begin with is when Moses is on the mountain lifting up the rod as Banner.

Exodus 17:9 And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow **I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.**

Exodus 17:10 So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and **Moses, Aaron,** and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

Two prophets Aaron and Moses went on to the top of the hill and the prophet Moses lifted up the rod as a person with a banner on a staff would lift up.

In the remembrance of the Rod being lifted up as a banner Moses built an altar and called the place on that mountain. Jahova Nissi which means the Lord is my Banner.

Exodus 17:15 And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it **Jehovahnissi:**

This is two prophets testifying of the Rod lifted up as a banner.

Moses and Aaron two prophets then testify to the tribes that they will have a stone each tribe with name written on it and they will have a banner to pledge to it for each of their tribes.

Numbers 2:1 And the Lord spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying,

Numbers 2:2 **Every man of the children of Israel shall pitch by his own standard, with the ensign** of their father's house: far off about the tabernacle of the congregation shall they pitch.

Numbers 2:3 And on the east side toward the rising of the sun shall **they of the standard of the camp** of Judah pitch throughout their armies: and Nahshon the son of Amminadab shall be captain of the children of Judah.

This is two prophets testifying of the banner of the tribes with each of them having a stone raising a banner to pledge to.

This is the foreshadow of the end times prophets lifting up a banner for the armies of the Lord testifying that they will have a banner and a stone.

This is foretold by Isaiah.

The prophet Isaiah prophesied of the armies of the Lord in the end times raising a banner for them all to come...

Isaiah 5:26 And **he will lift up an ensign to the nations** from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, **they shall come with speed swiftly:**

Moses had lifted up the banner on the mountain for the mighty ones for war...

Before the day of the Lord the Lord raises up the banner on high mountain to call the Army of the Lord.

Isaiah 13:2 **Lift ye up a banner upon the high mountain**, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.

Isaiah 13:3 I have commanded my sanctified ones, **I have also called my mighty ones** for mine anger, even them that rejoice in my highness.

Isaiah 13:4 The noise of a multitude in the mountains, like as of a great people; **a tumultuous noise of the kingdoms of nations gathered together: the Lord of hosts mustereth the host of the battle.**

Isaiah 13:5 **They come from a far country**, from the end of heaven, even the Lord, and the weapons of his indignation, to destroy the whole land.

This is the end times as the day of the Lord is at hand.

Isaiah 13:6 Howl ye; **for the day of the Lord is at hand**; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty.

When is this? The end times when the day of the Lord is at hand... theres a banner lifted up...

The two prophets of the end times are here testifying of the prophesy and the banner with stone.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

These are the two prophets.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because **these two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

What does Jesus say about sending His prophets?

He who rejects who is sent by Christ rejects Christ.

Matthew 10:40 He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.

Those who reject His prophet, reject Christ.

Those who receive His prophet receive the prophets reward.

Matthew 10:41 **He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward**; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.

Notice the “Receiveth”. Christ sends His prophet with the banner for the end times to gather His army.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and **will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written**, which no man knoweth saving **he that receiveth it**.

Those who dont receive the prophet giving the name of the white stone to unite the people dont receive whats written on the stone.

Those who receive the prophet sharing the white stone and the banner receive the reward of the prophet.

The gatherin of the Armies of the Lord the hosts of the Lord will have one banner and one stone for all the people.

There will no longer be multiple banners for each tribe and multiple stones for each tribe with their name each written on them.

There will be one banner for all His people and on the stone on the banner will be written the name “AMI” which says “my people”

The pledge to the banner that is lifted up in all corners of the earth and the call to COME.

Is the Spirit and the bride saying COME.

Rev 22:17 And **the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come.** And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

Those who have ears to hear say COME. He that Heareth says COME...

The Spirit and the bride are saying COME. Pledge to the banner and come.

Revelation 2:17 **He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches;** To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

He that heareth what the Spirit says to the Churches... whats the Spirit saying? COME.

What does the Spirit say to the churches about the stone? The white stone says AMI ... “my people”

The banner lifted up in the end times the people hear and COME

He whistles at them to come from far countries...

Isaiah 5:26 And **he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth:** and, behold, **they shall COME** with speed swiftly:

He lifts up the banner and the voice...

Isaiah 13:2 **Lift ye up a banner upon the high mountain, exalt the voice unto them,** shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.

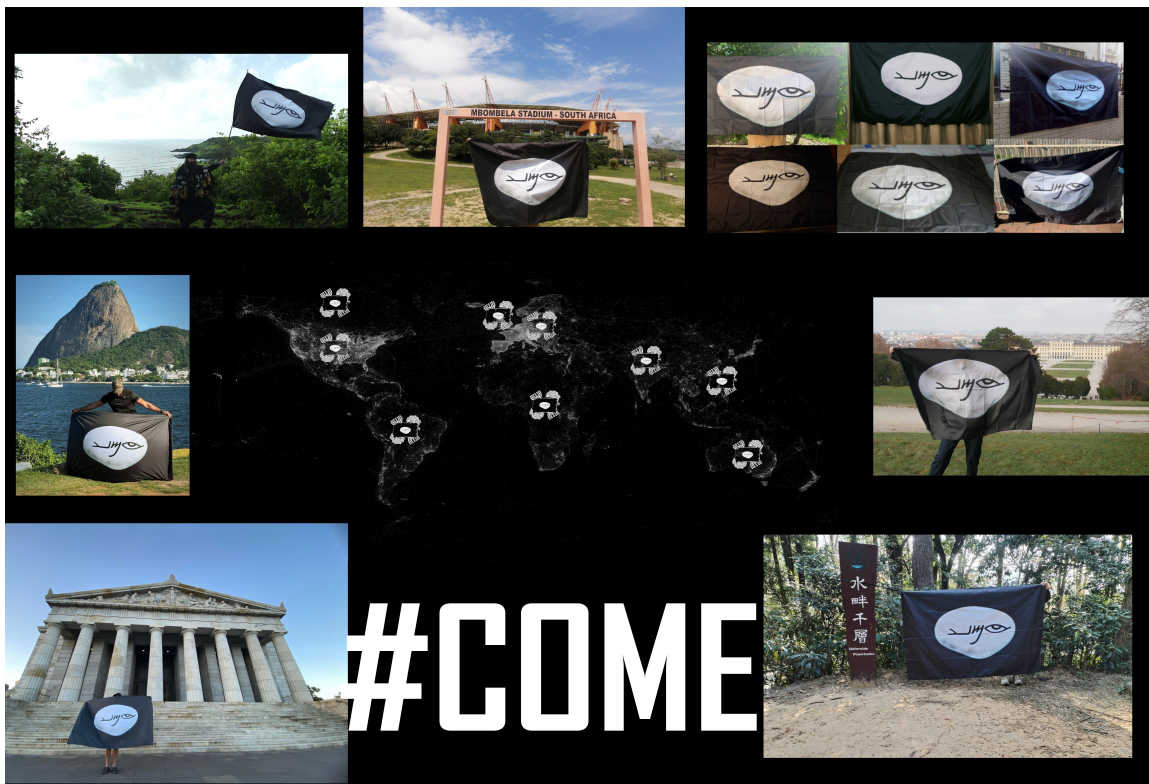
Exalt the voice to them saying COME.
