

Empty house

The end times prophesy is found in the stories of leaving the father and mothers house.

This is found from Geneiss to Abraham and onward in warning of Christ all prophetic foreshadow of the end times.

From the beggining the warning of what was at the end times is found in scripture.

Adam and Eve were the prophetic foreshadow of Christ and the Church as the apostles explained.

Quoting Genesis and explaining the church is Eve and Christ is the husband we see...

Ephesians 5:30 For we are members of **his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.**

Ephesians 5:31 For **this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife,** and they two shall be one flesh.

Ephesians 5:32 **This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.**

We see that the apostle explains based on Genesis the for this cause man and woman leave their mother and father and are joined to become one.

This is Genesis account.

Genesis 2:23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

Genesis 2:24 **Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother,** and shall cleave unto his **wife:** and they shall be one flesh.

This is prophetic foreshadow of the end times and the point to note here is that the man and woman leave their mother and father and are joined to become one which will be covered latter.

Abraham likewise is a prophetic foreshadow of the end times in his account as well.

Genesis 12:1 Now the Lord had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and **from thy father's house,** unto **a land that I will shew thee:**

Genesis 12:2 And **I will make of thee a great nation,** and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

Abraham departed leaving behind mother and father with his wife to the land of canaan to become a great nation.

Abraham gathered the souls to go with him to canaaan.

Genesis 12:5 And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that **they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran;** and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.

So we see that Abraham took his wife and gathered the souls to go to the land of canaan to become a great nation this is prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

Likewise Elisha and Elijah are prophetic foreshadows of end times with two prophets testifying of leaving mother and father behind.

1 Kings 19:19 So he departed thence, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who was plowing with twelve yoke of oxen before him, and he with the twelfth: and Elijah passed by him, and cast his mantle upon him.

1 Kings 19:20 And he left the oxen, and ran after Elijah, and said, **Let me, I pray thee, kiss my father and my mother, and then I will follow thee.** And he said unto him, Go back again: for what have I done to thee?

1 Kings 19:21 And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave unto the people, and they did eat. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and ministered unto him.

Two prophets left behind their mother and father to go prophesy which is prophetic utterance of the end times prophesy.

Christ explains this clearly in his explanations because in the end times its required...

Luke 9:59 And he said unto another, Follow me. But he said, Lord, **suffer me first to go and bury my father.**

Luke 9:60 Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.

Luke 9:61 And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; **but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.**

Luke 9:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

Christ warns that you have to leave the mother and father to follow Him.

Mark 10:29 And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, **There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's,**

Mark 10: But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.

Christ makes clear that those who do what's required by leaving the mother and father and going to come are not going to miss anything but inherit more than what they leave behind. This is all taught because of prophetic foreshadow of the end times...

and again Christ says...

Luke 14:26 If any man come to me, and **hate not his father, and mother**, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.

Luke 14:27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.  
And he finishes with saying

Luke 14:33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.

Christ Himself shows that He followed this example leaving behind His mother and Father to be joined with the bride in the kingdom which is prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

Luke 2:42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast.

Luke 2:43 And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, **the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not of it.**

Here we see Christ leaving mother and father going to Jerusalem..

Luke 2:44 But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among their kinsfolk and acquaintance.

Luke 2:45 And when they found him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking him.

We see Christ left mother and father and went to Jerusalem to gather at the temple.

Luke 2:46 And it came to pass, that after three days they **found him in the temple**, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

Christ then explains that its Gods will this be done.

Luke 2:49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that **I must be about my Father's business?**

This will all become clearer as now we will explain the prophesy of the end times.

The Church is called to leave mother and father and come Gather at Jerusalem for the end.

The land of Canaan is where Jerusalem is just like Abraham gathered the souls and went to the land of Canaan leaving mother and father.

Christ left mother and father to gather at the temple in Jerusalem just as the Church is to gather at the temple for the end times.

Two prophets testify of leaving the mother and father to go prophesy.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Like Adam and Eve left the garden to the wilderness, the bride leaves mother and father goes into the wilderness from Jerusalem to go meet the husband Christ.

Rev 12:14 And to **the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness**, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Here is where Christ leaves heaven where the Father is to come to meet the bride.

Rev 19:11 And **I saw heaven opened**, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Here is the gathering of the bride and husband leaving the Fathers house out of heaven to go to the land of canaan.

Rev 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, **coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.**

The bride leaves thier mother and father and goes to meet the husband and likewise the husband Christ leaves the Fathers house in heaven taking soul with him to earth to join and become one with the bride in the land of canaan becoming great nation.

This is the prophesy foreshadowed in all the stories from genesis to revelation from Adam and even, abraham, two prophets and Christs witness Himself

The church will be called to gather all souls to jerusalem leaving mother and father.

Then the church will go to be joined to be with the husband.

This is the prophesy of the empty house.
