

Stone nissi

The stories of Moses and Christ being lifted up are prophetic foreshadows of the end times prophesy.

There are multiple accounts testifying of this prophesy that the law is fulfilled for to be established.

The law states there is to be two or three witnesses and in the stories it testifies in the scripture.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

The first account is where Moses lifts up his staff and banner that unites the people in victory.

Exodus 17:9 And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill **with the rod of God in mine hand.**

Exodus 17:10 So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

Exodus 17:11 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

Exodus 17:12 But Moses hands were heavy; and **they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon;** and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

Moses lifted up his staff with a banner on it and you see a stone is what helped the banner stay up.

Exodus 17:15 And Moses built an altar, and called the **name of it Jehovahnissi:**

Because of the victory with the banner and stone moses made an altar to call the place the Lord is my banner or in hebrew Jehovah nissi.

We then see a second account where Moses lifts up the serpent.

Numbers 21:7 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the Lord, and against thee; pray unto the Lord, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people.

Numbers 21:8 And the Lord said unto Moses, **Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole:** and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.

Numbers 21:9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

Moses lifted up a banner that gave the people the victory over the serpent.

Christ in likeness was a foreshadow of this banner as well.

John 3:14 And as **Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:**

John 3:15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

Christ would heal those who looked upon Him on the cross but also HE would become a banner lifted up in the end times.

This is a prophetic foreshadow of the end times in all these events.

Christ is the Rock in the wilderness that Moses spoke of.

1 Cor 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and **that Rock was Christ.**

The warning that the things in past were written for examples of what the ends of the world are come.

1 Cor 10:9 Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and **were destroyed of serpents.**

1 Cor 10:10 Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer.

1 Cor 10:11 Now **all these things happened unto them for examples:** and they are written for our admonition, **upon whom the ends of the world are come.**

We see that Rock is Christ that is lifted up on the banner on all these occasions.

One at Jehova Nissi with a banner and stone victory over the war,

One at the wilderness with a banner lifted up having victory over the serpent.

One at Jerusalem with Christ lifted up as a banner having victory over death.

These are three accounts to all testify of the end times prophesy.

We have two testifying of the banner of the end times that is prophetic foretold in these events.

We have two testifying of the prophesy of the banner and those going into the wilderness for the end times for whom the end of the world has come. Having victory at Jerusalem over death.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a **thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

This is for the 1260 days of the end times.

We see that the woman is going into the wilderness having victory over the serpent.

Rev 12:14 And to **the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness**, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, **from the face of the serpent**.

We see she has victory over the serpent.

Rev 12:17 And **the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war** with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

We see the dragon going to make war and we have victory over the war.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

all of these accounts include the same likeness of what occurred prior.

One at Jehova Nissi with a banner and stone victory over the war with Moses.

One banner lifted up with banner and stone with victory over war in end times.

One at the wilderness with a banner lifted up having victory over the serpent with Moses.

One banner lifted up at wilderness having victory over the serpent in the end times.

One at Jerusalem with Christ lifted up as a banner having victory over death with Christ.

One banner at Jerusalem with victory over death in the end times.

The victory is given through the banner in the end.

Isa 5:26 And **he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far**, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:

The tribes in the nations belonging to Christ are called to come gather with the banner.

Isa 13:2 **Lift ye up a banner upon the high mountain**, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.

This banner has Christ the Rock on it a stone.

Revelation 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and **will give him a white stone**, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Everyone is united together under one stone banner for the end in the exodus to the wilderness until the great war that occurs at the return of Christ and those who lift this banner up will be victorious just as all the accounts afore mentioned.

Three witnesses testifying of the banner with the stone are two prophets, and the woman.

This is the Rock on the banner lifted up and that Rock is Christ.



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
