

Hidden prophesy

Many will have a hard time with all these prophecies being revealed not understanding the biblical nature of the revealing.

Christ himself explained by two witnesses that the things written in past even of the stories themselves had hidden signs of prophesy fulfillment for latter.

This is done by the law to prove a matter is established even in the story before you read it.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses**, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

Here is one account where Christ confirms this.

Matthew 12:38 (KJV) Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would **see a sign from thee**.

The religious leaders ask Christ to show a sign that they wanted proof He is who He says He is.

The proof He gives them is the hidden unveiling of the prophesy in the stories already written.

Matthew 12:39 (KJV) But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and **there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:**

Christ in one account says the sign of the prophet Jonah is a testimony.

Matthew 12:40 (KJV) **For as Jonas was three days** and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

The people were looking for a sign and they pointed to the coming of Elijah Christ had this to say.

Matt 17:10 And his disciples asked him, saying, **Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come?**

Matt 17:11 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things.

Matt 17:12 But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them.

Matt 17:13 Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist.

We see the two accounts that Christ explains about the hidden prophesy of things to come is found in the stories of the past.

This is proof that the fulfillment of things in the end times will be hidden prophesy in stories of old.

This is the two signs hidden in the prophesy that are two witnesses of the prophesy of the end times.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and **they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

This is the two witnesses of hidden prophesy of end times found in the stories of old.

Two prophets as Jonah like Christ and John in likeness of Elijah

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these **two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

Prophet John in the likeness of Elijah clothed in sackclothe and being killed.

Rev 11:7 And when **they shall have finished their testimony**, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, **and kill them.**

Prophet Jonah as Christ in the belly of the whale after three days being killed Resurrected.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days** and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and **they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

This is two prophets testifying of the same fashion of hidden prophesy and not just these two but all the ones being revealed now are more then enough signs given.

The stories being unveiled with hidden prophesy is the sign given.
