

Finger of God

The scroll and that which is written on it on both sides that goes forth will be revealed through this.

What is written on two sides by the finger of God?

Exodus 31:18 (KJV) And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, **two tables of testimony**, tables of stone, **written with the finger of God**.

The ten commandments were written on two sides of tablets by the finger of God.

The prophet Zechariah saw the flying scroll with writing on both sides.

Zech 5:1 Then I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and **behold a flying roll**.

Zech 5:2 And he said unto me, What seest thou? And I answered, I see a flying roll; the length thereof is twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof ten cubits.

Zech 5:3 Then said he unto me, **This is the curse that goeth forth over the face of the whole earth**: for every one that **stealeth shall be cut off as on this side** according to it; and every one that **swaureth shall be cut off as on that side** according to it.

Zech 5:4 **I will bring it forth, saith the Lord of hosts**, and it shall enter into **the house of the thief**, and into the house of him that **swaureth falsely by my name**: and it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.

What are the plagues and curses that goeth forth over the entire earth because of the violations of the law? of stealing, bearing false witness and taking the name of the Lord in vain?

The law states on one side of the two tablets.

Exodus 20:7 Thou shalt not take **the name of the Lord thy God in vain**; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

And in the latter side of the two tablets tablets its written.

Exodus 20:15 Thou shalt **not steal**.

Exodus 20:16 Thou shalt **not bear false witness** against thy neighbour.

What plagues and curses come over the entire earth from these law violations?

The plagues and curses written in the warning of violating the commandments.

Deut 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to **observe to do all his commandments** and his statutes which I command thee this day; that **all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee**:

The curses and plagues written in the law come upon the earth in the end times.

This is the finger of God of plagues that came upon pharaoh from the violations of the law.

Exodus 8:17 And they did so; for Aaron stretched out his hand with his rod, and **smote the dust of the earth, and it became lice in man**, and in beast; all the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt.

Exodus 8:19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, **This is the finger of God**: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the Lord had said.

From the right hand the law comes forward a fiery law.

Deut 33:2 And he said, The Lord came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir unto them; he shined forth from mount Paran, and he came with ten thousands of saints: from **his right hand went a fiery law for them**.

Deut 33:3 Yea, he loved the people; all his saints are in thy hand: and they sat down at thy feet; every one shall receive of thy words.

The right hand had a scroll in it that was given to the prophet Ezekiel.

Ezek 2:9 And when I looked, behold, **an hand was sent unto me**; and, lo, **a roll of a book was therein**;

Ezek 2:10 And **he spread it before me; and it was written within and without**: and there was written therein lamentations, and mourning, and woe.

Its was written on both sides of that scroll...

The path of the righteous at the right hand is to be on the right side of the law at the right hand.

There is only one who is worthy to have the scroll at the throne in his right hand which means he fulfilled the entire law perfectly and judges with the law perfectly at his right hand.

That is Christ at the right hand of the Father with the scroll in the right hand.

Rev 5:5 And **I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals**.

Rev 5:2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

Rev 5:3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

Rev 5:4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the **Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book**, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

It is Christ that is the only one worthy to open the book and judge by the law.

Christ is at the right hand of the Father.

Which is Christ spoken of by David that the Lord says to my Lord...

Psalm 110:1 The **Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand**, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

As Christ said to to them.

Luke 22:69 Hereafter shall the **Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.**

As the scriptures testify that it is Christ who sat at the right hand of God.

Mark 16:19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and **sat on the right hand of God.**

The apostles testify Christ is at the right hand of the Father.

Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even **at the right hand of God**, who also maketh intercession for us.

Who blessed Stephen testified against the Jews for not keeping the law and then testified to see Christ at the right and of the Father...

Acts 7:53 **Who have received the law** by the disposition of angels, and **have not kept it.**

Acts 7:54 When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth.

Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, **looked up stedfastly into heaven**, and saw the glory of God, and **Jesus standing on the right hand of God**,

Acts 7:56 And said, Behold, **I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.**

The testimony of the law and Christ standing at the right hand of God is used in same context.

The one like Jasper sitting on the throne.

Rev 4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, **a throne was set in heaven**, and **one sat on the throne.**

Rev 4:3 And **he that sat was to look upon like a jasper** and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

Jasper is the stone of Benjamin which Benjamins name means "Son of the right hand"

Christ is the Son of the right hand.

Christ talks about those in the Kingdom being at the right hand.

Matthew 25:34 Then shall the **King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father,** inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

The way into the city of the kingdom is through keeping the commandments which makes you blessed.

Rev 22:14 **Blessed are they that do his commandments,** that they may have right to the tree of life, and **may enter in through the gates into the city.**

Those at the right hand are those who keep the law who are “blessed of my Father”.

This law is in the right hand again we see the angel with the scroll in his hand.

Rev 10:2 And **he had in his hand a little book open:** and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

The scroll is taken out of the right hand.

Rev 10:8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, **Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel** which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

Rev 10:9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

Rev 10:10 And **I took the little book out of the angel's hand,** and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

Rev 10:11 And he said unto me, **Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.**

The scroll is given to the prophet to prophesy for the end times to everyone on earth again.

Just as the scroll was brought out the temple to be read in front of all.

2 Kings 22:8 And Hilkiyah the high priest said unto Shaphan the scribe, **I have found the book of the law in the house of the Lord.** And Hilkiyah gave **the book to Shaphan, and he read it.**

What goes forth? the law and curse of plagues of the law goes forth from Jerusalem.

Zech 5:3 Then said he unto me, **This is the curse that goeth forth** over the face of the whole earth: for every one that stealeth shall be cut off as on this side according to it; and every one that sweareth shall be cut off as on that side according to it.

The law goes forth for judgement and instruction from Jerusalem.

Isaiah 51:4 “Pay attention to Me, O My people, And give ear to Me, O My nation; **For a law will go forth from Me,** And I will set My justice for a light of the peoples.

Isa 2:3 And many people shall go and say, **Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord**, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and **we will walk in his paths**: for out of Zion **shall go forth the law**, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

On Christs return in the latter days the people will be gathered and return to Jerusalem with the law.

Micah 4:4 **But in the last days it shall come to pass**, that the mountain of the house of the Lord shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it.

Micah 4:2 And **many nations shall come**, and say, **Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord**, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: **for the law shall go forth of Zion**, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

Micah 4:3 And **he shall judge among many people**, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

Christ shall Judge with the law on his return at the seventh seal being opened by Him.

Out of the right hand the fiery law comes and its spoken by His prophets.

Deut 33:2 And he said, The Lord came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir unto them; he shined forth from mount Paran, and he came with ten thousands of saints: from **his right hand went a fiery law for them**.

This fire is the feiry law that proceeds out of the mouth.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the **two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth**.

Rev 11:5 **And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth**, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

The feiry law proceeds forth from the mouth which is the burning flame of the law.

These two candles burn with the fire. These hearts have waxed cold from no fire in the law of their hearts and when the candle has fire it burns and melts the wax from the heat.

Matt 24:12 And because **iniquity shall abound**, the love of many **shall wax cold**.

The iniquity is the violaiton of the law which is the sin from violation of the law that they wax cold and harden like a candle without feiry flame.

The day cometh burning like a fiery oven with the flame of fire burning and the reminder of the days of Moses of old that was spoken with the law is reference to the end and the scroll and curse.

This is all reference to the law.

Malachi 4:1 For, **behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven;** and all the proud, yea, and all that **do wickedly, shall be stubble:** and **the day that cometh shall burn them up,** saith the Lord of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

Malachi 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.
Wicked trodden down as burnt ashes from the fire of the law.

Malachi 4:3 And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith the Lord of hosts.

Malachi 4:4 **Remember ye the law of Moses my servant,** which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and judgments.

Malachi 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord:

Malachi 4:6 And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, **lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.**

The curse is smitten on the earth from the law violations in the scroll and the finger of God.

Lord hands the scroll to two prophets two witnesses to prophesy against the world.

This scroll of the law goes forth from Jerusalem as prophesy and fire of the law,

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The finger of God of the plagues and the law that come on the violators of earth.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.**

Those guilty in the world will be put to death by the law out of the mouth of two witnesses it will proceed why its justified by the law the plagues and curses.

This is why anyone who tries to harm according to the law must be put to death according to law.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and **if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.**

The order of the law requires two witnesses in order to put those in the world to death.

Deut 17:5 Then shalt thou bring forth that man or that woman, which have committed that wicked thing, unto thy gates, even that man or that woman, and shalt stone them with stones, till they die.

Deut 17:6 At **the mouth of two witnesses**, or three witnesses, **shall he that is worthy of death be put to death**; but at the mouth of one witness he shall not be put to death.

Deut 17:7 **The hands of the witnesses shall be first upon him to put him to death**, and afterward the hands of all the people. So thou shalt put the evil away from among you.

The deaths of the plagues and curses and prophesy of the law in the end times is the scroll prophesied of the law and its seals before Christ the third witness comes.

Deuteronomy 17:18 “Now it shall come about, when **he sits on the throne of his kingdom**, that he shall write for himself a copy of this Law **on a scroll** in the presence of the Levitical priests.

The heavens open at the day of the Lord, the sixth seal and the scroll is unsealed for the Judge.

By the seventh seal the scroll is fully opened like heaven is opened like a scroll.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when **he had opened the sixth seal**, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

Rev 6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

Rev 6:14 And **the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together**; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

As the scroll is unsealed in prophesy it unravels at the same time the heavens unravel as Christ comes out at the end of the 1260 days.

Rev 19:11 And **I saw heaven opened**, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and **in righteousness he doth judge** and make war.

Christ with the double edged sword from his mouth.

Rev 19:15 And **out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations**: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Rev 1:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and **out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword**: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

The things written on two sides of the scroll making it have two edges that cut on both sides.

The words of the law are the word of God.

Heb 4:12 For the **word of God** is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any **twoedged sword**, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Those that fight against him will be slain by the same word of the law.

Rev 19:21 And **the remnant were slain with the sword of him** that sat upon the horse, which **sword proceeded out of his mouth:** and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

The scroll written on both sides is the ten commandments, the writing of the finger of God.
