

## Whirlwind

The four winds and gathering of the tribes for the end times is seen in the gathering of the four horses of the apocalypse which is the twelve tribes including the ten lost tribes.

The Lord had scattered the tribes to the four winds of the earth.

Zech 7:11 But they refused to hearken, and pulled away the shoulder, and stopped their ears, that they should not hear.

Zech 7:12 Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the Lord of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the Lord of hosts.

Zech 7:13 Therefore it is come to pass, that as he cried, and they would not hear; so they cried, and I would not hear, saith the Lord of hosts:

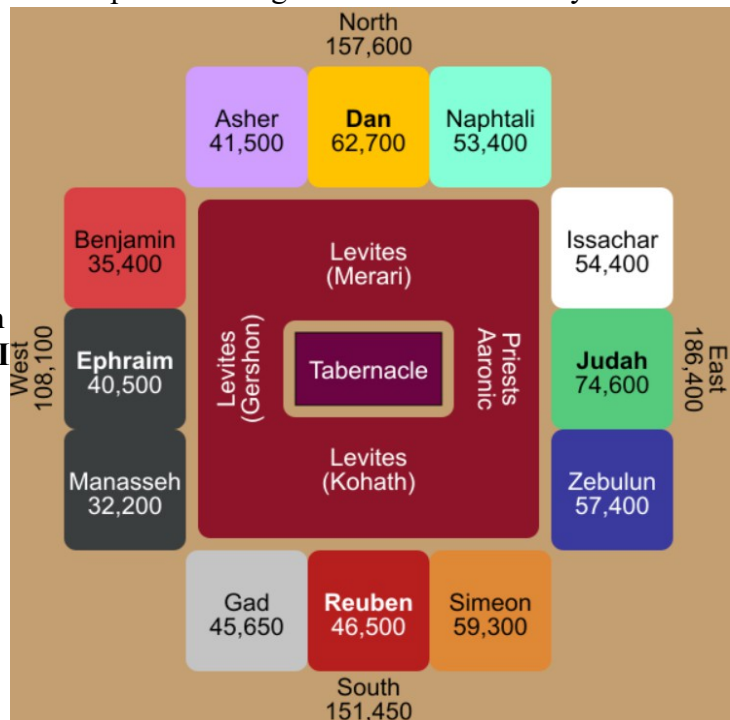
Zech 7:14 But **I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations** whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate

This whirlwind scattered them to the four corners of the earth.

The four divisions of the tribes to the east, west, south and the north.

Zech 2:6 Ho, ho, come forth, and flee from the land of the north, saith the LORD: **for I have spread you abroad as the four winds of the heaven**, saith the LORD.

In the talking about the four horses this is clearly seen that this is the four horses of the divisions.



East lead by Judah with Issachar and Zebulun.

South lead by Reuben with Simeon and Gad

West lead by Ephraim with Manassa and Benjamin

North lead by Dan with Asher and Nephthali

Four divisions of the four winds with the four riders who lead the charge of each division.

These are the four divisions of the tribes riders called to come.

A white horse in one direction.

Rev 6:6 And I saw when the Lamb opened **one of the seals**, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, **one of the four beasts** saying, **Come** and see.

Rev 6:2 And I saw, and behold a **white horse**: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

A red horse in one direction.

Rev 6:3 And when he had opened the **second seal**, I heard the **second beast say, Come** and see.

Rev 6:4 And there went out another **horse that was red**: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

A black horse in one direction.

Rev 6:5 And when he had **opened the third seal**, I heard the **third beast say, Come** and see. And I beheld, and lo **a black horse**; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

Rev 6:6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

And a green horse in one direction.

Rev 6:7 And when he had opened the **fourth seal**, I heard the voice of **the fourth beast say, Come** and see.

Rev 6:8 And I looked, and behold **a pale horse**: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

This is the four directions with the four divisions of colors with the four horses which are the lost tribes coming back.

And the gathering of the tribes under one banner for the end is found in the prophesy for the day of the Lord in the four winds.

Isaiah 11:12 **12 And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.**



The four winds are held from blowing the whirlwind to gather the tribes by the hand of four angels.

Rev 7:7 And after these things **I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth**, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

These four angels with the power over the four winds are the preparation for the four divisions of the tribes of Israel to be gathered with the elect in the four corners of the earth by the winds blowing together.

This is the whirlwind that brings them back from the four corners of the earth and when the four winds blowing them together into one location occurs it becomes a mighty wind at the location.

This is what occurred at the pentecost they were all from all nations gathered together to Jerusalem and the wind came and then they left out to all the nations at the next day.

Acts 2:2 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Acts 2:2 And suddenly there came a **sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind**, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

Acts 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:5 And **there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven**.

This wind brings them all back to Jerusalem where the Spirit is again poured out on the coming pentecost that occurs with the tribes and remnant gathered together.

The following verses after the four winds reveals its referring to the tribes of Israel.

Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of **all the tribes of the children of Israel**.

Rev 7:5 Of the **tribe of Juda** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Reuben** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Gad** were sealed twelve thousand.

Rev 7:6 Of the **tribe of Aser** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Nephthalim** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Manasses** were sealed twelve thousand.

Rev 7:7 Of the **tribe of Simeon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Levi** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Issachar** were sealed twelve thousand.

Rev 7:8 Of the **tribe of Zabulon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Joseph** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the **tribe of Benjamin** were sealed twelve thousand.

This is the four divisions of the twelve tribes gathered to Israel for the next pentecost by the four winds creating the mighty rushing whirlwind when they are gathered from the four corners of the earth to Jerusalem when their four riders leading the four divisions come.

This is the prophesy of the four winds whirlwind.
