

Euphrates two

The foreshadow of the end times prophesy Euphrates drying up and chariots being seen is found in the story of Elijah and Elisha.

2 Kings 2:6 And Elijah said unto him, Tarry, I pray thee, here; for the LORD hath sent me to Jordan. And he said, As the LORD liveth, and as thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. And they two went on.

2 Kings 2:7 And fifty men of the sons of the prophets went, and stood to view afar off: and they two stood by Jordan.

2 Kings 2:8 And Elijah took his mantle, and wrapped it together, and **smote the waters, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.**

2 Kings 2:9 And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that **Elijah said unto Elisha,** Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.

2 Kings 2:10 And he said, Thou hast asked a hard thing: nevertheless, if thou see me when I am taken from thee, it shall be so unto thee; but if not, it shall not be so.

2 Kings 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a **chariot of fire, and horses of fire,** and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

2 Kings 2:12 And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, **the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof.** And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.

We see that two prophets were prophesying and smote the river that dried up for people to cross and they saw Chariots and horsemen of the armies of the Lord.

This is the prophetic foreshadow of the end times prophesy.

Two prophets are prophesying

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Two prophets.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these **two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

We see two prophesying and power to smite the waters with plagues.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have **power over waters** to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues,** as often as they will.

Two prophets plague the river Euphrates causing the plague on the Euphrates river to split into two to dry up is seen in the 6th trumpet and 6th bowl.

Rev 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon **the great river Euphrates**; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

Rivers made way for crossing and chariots appear with those coming across.

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

Rev 9:14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in **the great river Euphrates**.

Rev 9:15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

Rev 9:16 And the number of the **army of the horsemen** were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

These horsemen and chariots are those used as armies of the Lord coming across the Euphrates.

These are the net of company coming to snare the beasts armies that slays a third of earth.

Ezek 32: 3 Thus saith the Lord God; I will therefore spread **out my net over thee with a company of many people; and they shall bring thee up in my net**.

Ezek 32:4 Then will I leave thee upon the land, I will cast thee forth upon the open field, and will cause all the fowls of the heaven to remain upon thee, and I will fill the beasts of the whole earth with thee.

Ezek 32:5 And I will lay thy flesh upon the mountains, and fill the valleys with thy height.

Ezek 32:6 **I will also water with thy blood the land wherein thou swimst, even to the mountains; and the rivers shall be full of thee**.

Ezek 32:7 And when I shall put thee out, I will cover the heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light.

Ezek 32:8 All the bright lights of heaven will I make dark over thee, and set darkness upon thy land, saith the Lord God.

The prophesy of the two prophets prophesying the drying of the river for people to cross and seeing the chariots and horsemen army of the Lord found in the story of Elijah and Elisha is the prophesy of the end times.
