

Scroll sky

The prophesy of the unsealing of the scroll by the seventh seal opening unravels the scroll and the sky unravels like a scroll on that day of the seventh seal at the same time.

This will make this very clear on the prophesy of the seventh seal and the unraveling of the sky at the same time of the scroll.

First we look to the scroll.

Rev 5:5 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, **sealed with seven seals**.

We see the scroll with the seven seals.

When the seals of a scroll begin to be loosened the scroll will no longer stay rolled together and will begin to unravel at the last seal.



Christ begins to unseal the scroll in the end for His coming.

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to **loose the seven seals thereof**.

These seals loose in the order

Rev 6:6 And I saw when the **Lamb opened one of the seals**, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

By the sixth seal it is the end of the tribulation at the day of the Lord.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had **opened the sixth seal**, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

Rev 6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

Rev 6:14 And **the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together**; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

Here we see that heavens begin to depart like a scroll when its rolled together.

The seventh seal is loosed as the scroll is opened..

Rev 8:1 And when he had **opened the seventh seal**, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

This is when the heaven is opened as a scroll.

The wrath of Christ is about to come into the earth with heaven opened like a scroll.

Rev 19:11 And **I saw heaven opened**, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

Here we see the heavens opened like a scroll.

Isaiah 34:4 And all the host of heaven shall be dissolved, and **the heavens shall be rolled together as a scroll**: and all their host shall fall down, as the leaf falleth off from the vine, and as a falling fig from the fig tree.

Isaiah 34:5 For **my sword shall be bathed in heaven**: behold, it shall come down upon Idumea, and upon the people of my curse, to judgment.

This sword is the double edged sword bathed in heaven.

Rev 19:15 And **out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword**, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

That sword bathed in heaven is the scroll written on both sides to be executed on the earth.

Rev 5:5 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a **book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals**.

The double edged sword two sides of the scroll coming out of his mouth.

Rev 1:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and **out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword**: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

The scroll last seal is loosened on the day of the Lord when the sun and moon is darkened as heaven is opened like a scroll and Christ comes out a portal of heaven like a scroll opened up.



He comes out with the scroll in his mouth to execute the earth with the law written on both sides.

The sky opens as that scroll opens..
