

The Weatherman

The parables of Christ in the rebuke of the signs of the times and the weather to the pharisees are a prophetic foreshadow of the things of the end times.

The statement about the pharisees looking to the weather and knowing what's to come but not able to see the signs of the times is much deeper than just a rebuke.

Matt 16:1 The Pharisees also with the Sadducees came, and tempting desired **him that he would shew them a sign from heaven.**

They wanted to see signs in the heavens that Christ was the one.

Matt 16:2 He answered and said unto them, **When it is evening, ye say, It will be fair weather: for the sky is red.**

Matt 16:3 And in **the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowering.** O ye hypocrites, **ye can discern the face of the sky;** but can ye not discern the signs of the times?

Christ then gives two witnesses to testify against them in explanation of the weather about what was to come.

This is prophetic significance to what occurs in the end times prophecy.

The Lord sends two witnesses to testify against them.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, **that it rain not in the days of their prophecy:** and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Giving signs in the heaven and the weather, clouds without rain and signs in the heavens.

The rain is withheld after the wind blows on the sea.

Rev 7:7 And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the **four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow** on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

Rev 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

The winds are released on the sea and the beast then rises out of the sea.

Just like Daniel.

Daniel 7:2 Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, **the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.**

Daniel 7:3 And **four great beasts came up from the sea**, diverse one from another.

When the winds blow the beasts rise up out of the sea from the storm.

Rev 13:13 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and **saw a beast rise up out of the sea**, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

I see the storm over the sea and the wind strove on the sea and caused the sea to become temultrous and I knew that a storm was coming to the earth but in the storm there would be no rain.

A sign to the wicked generation .

Cloud without rain and wicked trees that get plucked up by the roots.

Jude 1:11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

Jude 1:12 These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: **clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth**, without fruit, **twice dead, plucked up by the roots;**

The storm brewing that comes with no rain.

And you want to see signs in the heavens? Youll be given signs in the heavens.

A wicked generation you are.

Rev 8:6 And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

Rev 8:12 12 And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

And the sign in the heavens of the Sun and the Moon darkened will be given to you.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and **the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;**

The wind and storm without rain and the signs in the heavens with two witnesses.
