

Thunder sons

Christ naming two sons of thunder is a prophetic foreshadow of the prophesy of the end times.

First looking to the prophetic foreshadow in the story of Christ.

The two called James and John had asked if the Lord wanted them to call down fire from heaven.

Luke 9:54 And when his disciples **James and John** saw this, they said, Lord, **wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven**, and consume them, even as Elias did?

Luke 9:55 But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of.

Christ calls these two Boanerges which translates sons of thunder.

Mark 3:17 And **James** the son of Zebedee, **and John** the brother of James; and he surnamed them **Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder**:

This is the prophesy of the end times foreshadowed and put into the stories and actions of Christ.

The two who call down fire from heaven and are sons of thunder.

This is said that the matter be established by the law of two witnesses.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses**, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

Here is the fulfillment of this in the end times.

In the end times theres two named by Christ.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, **and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The calling down of fire and thunder of the judgements.

Rev8:5 And the angel took the censer, and filled it with **fire of the altar**, and **cast it into the earth**: and there were voices, and **thunderings**, and lightnings, and an earthquake.

Rev 8:6 And the seven angels which had **the seven trumpets** prepared themselves to sound.

Rev 8:7 The **first angel sounded**, **and there followed hail and fire mingled** with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

We see the prophesying of the fire coming down and the thunders.

This seven judgements is the seven thunders.

The prophesying of the scroll of the seven seals and judgements

Rev 10:2 And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

Rev 10:3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

Rev 10:4 And when **the seven thunders had uttered their voices**, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, **Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.**

These seven thunders are to be prophesied in the seven judgements of the seven angels from the throne of God declaring Gods judgements.

The mystery of the seven thunders once the seventh trumpets sounded will be finished because those seven voices are the seven voices of the seven angels of the seven trumpets declaring Gods voice of these.

Rev 10:7 But in the **days of the voice of the seventh angel**, when he shall begin to sound, **the mystery of God should be finished**, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets

Voice of the prophets will be declaring these seven trumpets on behalf of God which is the voice of the seven trumpets from God.

Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, **as he hath declared to his servants the prophets**

As he has declared to his servants the prophets.

The seventh angel finishes.

Rev 11:15 And **the seventh angel sounded**; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

And the thunderings finished and are seen for all confirmed in heaven.

Rev 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, **and thunderings**, and an earthquake, and great hail.

The story of Christ with John and James being the sons of thunder calling down fire from heaven is the prophecy of the end times hidden in the gospels.

The sons of thunder are the two prophets of the end times.
