

Altar measure

The prophesy warns about the end times third temple and about taking a look at its altar to find out what temple they are looking at.

This is not the messiahs temple and when you look to the altar it becomes clear why this is written.

The prophesy begins in Revelation with this explaining to us.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, **and the altar**, and them that worship therein.

Rev 11:2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto **the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months.**

We see measuring the altar and noticing that Gentiles will be trampling the city underfoot.

This is the time of the Antichrist ruling from Jerusalem for the forty two months which is the 1260 days of the plagues and prophesy being prophesied of judgements on Jerusalem and world.

This is the same time of the last 1260 days or 42 months mentioned in the verses following.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a **thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

This is also the same period where those gathered at Jerusalem in sackclothe exodus out for the wilderness for 42 months.

Rev 12:6 And **the woman fled into the wilderness**, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there **a thousand two hundred and threescore days.**

Now looking to the third temple during this time it says to take a measurement of this altar.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and **the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure** the temple of God, **and the altar**, and them that worship therein.

This statement is made to measure which means to take a close look at and inspect for error.

This is to let us know that its not a temple that is the Messiahs temple and the altar will be a key for people to notice this.

We will look to Ezekiel's talk of a coming Messiah temple but Ezekiel also talks about a temple that is NOT the Messiah's temple that he is describing and that is found here.

Ezek 8:5 Then said he unto me, Son of man, lift up thine eyes now the way toward the north. So I lifted up mine eyes the way toward the north, and **behold northward at the gate of the altar this image of jealousy in the entry.**

There is an Image of Jealousy at the gate of the altar.

This is the Image of Jealousy that provokes the Lord to jealousy.

Ezek 8:3 And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; **where was the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.**

This image of Jealousy is the Image of the beast.

So we see that near the door to the altar is where the image of the beast will be.

Rev 13:15 And **he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak**, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Now about measuring the altar itself let's look further into this altar.

When the men come into the gates with slaughtering weapons in Ezekiel they go next to an altar.

Ezek 9:9 He cried also in mine ears with a loud voice, saying, Cause them that have charge over the city to draw near, even every man with his destroying weapon in his hand.

Ezek 9:2 And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them was clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and **they went in, and stood beside the brasen altar.**

This Altar is made of brass. We know that the Altar is told for us to measure it to see if it's correct.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and **the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure** the temple of God, **and the altar**, and them that worship therein.

Rev 11:2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto **the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months.**

So we see this altar is a brass altar and it will be a clue for us in this revelation.

We see in Ezekiel's prophecy near that altar where the Image of Jealousy is set up that the people are slain at this temple.

This obviously is not the Messiah's temple but when the Gentiles tread underfoot the city.

The Lord says to **DEFILE** this temple with the bodies of slain at this temple.

Ezek 9:5 And to the others he said in mine hearing, Go ye after him through the city, and smite: let not your eye spare, neither have ye pity:

Ezek 9:6 Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom is the mark; **and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which were before the house.**

Ezek 9:7 And he said unto them, **Defile the house, and fill the courts with the slain:** go ye forth. And they went forth, and **slew in the city.**

This temple has a brass altar and its not the Messiahs temple.

Ezek 9:2 And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them was clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, **and stood beside the brasen altar.**

This is a clue why we are to measure the altar when the Gentiles come in, for the coming temple which is a temple in the end times after Johns revelation was given.

This is key because Solomons temple was the temple that had the Altar of **BRASS**.

We know that Solomons temple already was destroyed and Ezekiels prophesy is about a temple that had the image of jealousy erected and that temple is the end times temple which comes latter.

We know this because Herods temple did not have a brass altar and did not have the image of Jealousy set up and that was not fulfilled at Herods temple.

Solomons temple had the altar of brass prior according to the bible and we see this here.

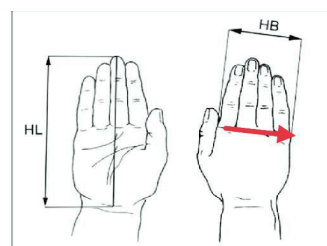
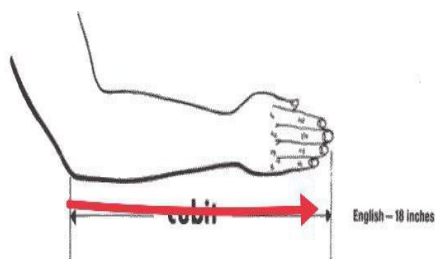
2 Chron 4:1 Moreover he made an **altar of brass**, twenty cubits the length thereof, and twenty cubits the breadth thereof, and ten cubits the height thereof.

Solomons brass altar was 20 cubits in length and 20 cubits in breadth and ten cubits high.

In Ezekiels Millenium temple of the Messiah the Altar has a different measures then Solomons.

Ezek 43:13 And these are the measures of the altar after the cubits: **The cubit is a cubit and an hand breadth; even the bottom shall be a cubit, and the breadth a cubit**, and the border thereof by the edge thereof round about shall be a span: and this shall be the higher place of the altar.

In Ezekiels prophesy of the Messiah temple he gives the special measure of a cubit and a hand breadth for one of the cubits.



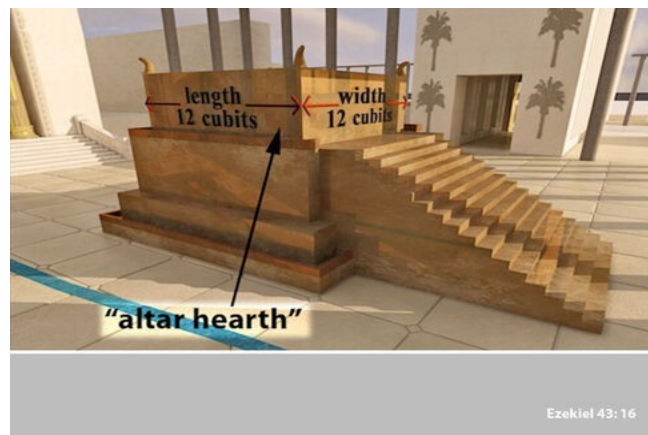
We continue to see that the altar of Messiah has different measurements given.

Ezek 43:14 And from the bottom upon the ground even to the lower settle shall be two cubits, and the breadth one cubit; and from the lesser settle even to the greater settle shall be four cubits, and the breadth one cubit.

Ezek 43:15 So the altar shall be four cubits; and from the altar and upward shall be four horns.

Ezek 43:16 And **the altar** shall be **twelve cubits long, twelve broad, square in the four squares thereof.**

This is 12 cubits by 12 cubits and this altar is NOT made of brass but gold which will be covered further.



So we see Solomons temple brass altar is measured at 20 cubits by 20 cubits.

2 Chron 4:1 Moreover he made an **altar of brass, twenty cubits the length thereof, and twenty cubits the breadth thereof,** and ten cubits the height thereof.

This is clearly two distinct altars one of brass of solomons time and the end times messiah altar

Ezekiel says the end times messiah altar is 12 cubits by 12 cubits and Solomons temple of brass is found in the 20 cubits by 20 cubits measurement.

This 12 cubits by 12 cubits measure is the measure of the Temple of the Messiah.

Isaiah talks about the gates that will be open for the nations to come to Messiahs temple.

Isaiah 60:11 Therefore **thy gates shall be open continually;** they **shall not be shut day nor night;** that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought.

These gates are not shut day or night and so we know this is about the end times temple.

When looking to the Revelation we see this is described.

Rev 21:24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

Rev 21:25 And **the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day:** for there shall be no night there.

So in these verses we will find clues about the altar in the future of this temple of Messiah.

In Isaiah we see that the prophesy says that instead of brass in the temple of Messiah that those things that were brass prior known to the Jews temple would be switched with gold.

Isaiah 60:17 **For brass I will bring gold**, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness.

So we know that the Third Temple to see if its the Messiahs temple would have the Dimenions mentioned in Ezekiel of the altar and instead of brass it would be made of Gold.

The nations will bring all the gold for the messiah to build the city and the house of the Lord.

ESV Isaiah 60:5 Then you shall see and be radiant; your heart shall thrill and exult, because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, **the wealth of the nations shall come to you.**

Isaiah 60:6 The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; all they from Sheba shall come: **they shall bring gold** and incense; and they shall shew forth the praises of the Lord.

Isaiah 60:7 All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together unto thee, the rams of Nebaioth shall minister unto thee: **they shall come up with acceptance on mine altar, and I will glorify the house of my glory.**

Isaiah 60:9 Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver **and their gold with them**, unto the name of the Lord thy God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he hath glorified thee.

The nations wealth brought with the gold for the offering for the Messiahs temple.

Zech 14:14 And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and **the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold**, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

Even the Reed to measure the Messiahs city will be gold.

Rev 21:15 And he that talked with me **had a golden reed to measure the city**, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.

Everything including the Altar will be made of gold as Isaiahs prophesy in Isaiah says about switching things brass for gold.

Rev 21:18 And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and **the city was pure gold**, like unto clear glass.

The city is pure gold.

Rev 21:21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: **and the street of the city was pure gold**, as it were transparent glass.

The streets are pure gold.

So here is the clues for knowing the end times third temple is not the messiahs temple.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and **the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure** the temple of God, **and the altar**, and **them that worship therein**.

Now taking a measurement of the altar and the people who worship at this third temple..

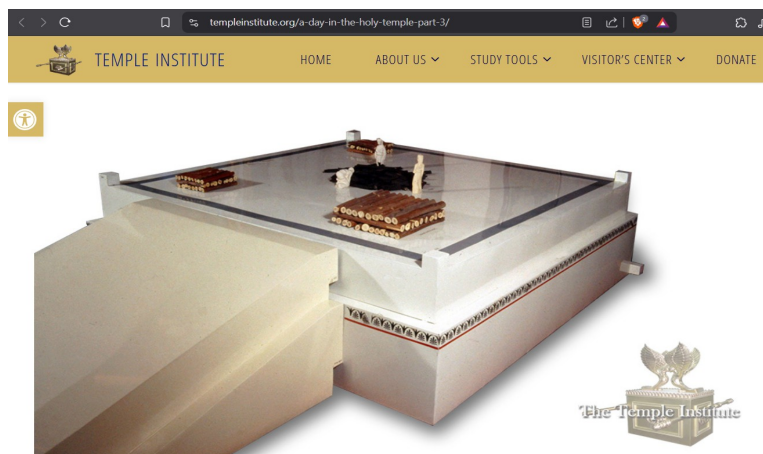
Who are the people who worship at this temple? They are unbelieving Jews who reject the messiah.

Measuring these people are they correct? no.

Theyll have the wrong measurements for messiah temple.

What about the altars they are suggesting and their measures?

One of their altars one of the groups is suggesting has a dimension.



“The altar was built as a perfect square and was quite large: it reached a height of 10 amot (app. 5 meters) and **its width was 32 amot (app. 16 meters).**”

Its 5 meters high and 16 meters wide. 16 meters is aprox 52 and half feet.

So lets look at this compared to Ezekiels measurements of the Messiahs temple.

In Ezekiel the messiahs altar measurements are clear.

Ezek 43:13 And these are **the measures of the altar after the cubits: The cubit is a cubit and an hand breadth**; even the bottom shall be a cubit, and the breadth a cubit, and the border thereof by the edge thereof round about shall be a span: and this shall be the higher place of the altar.

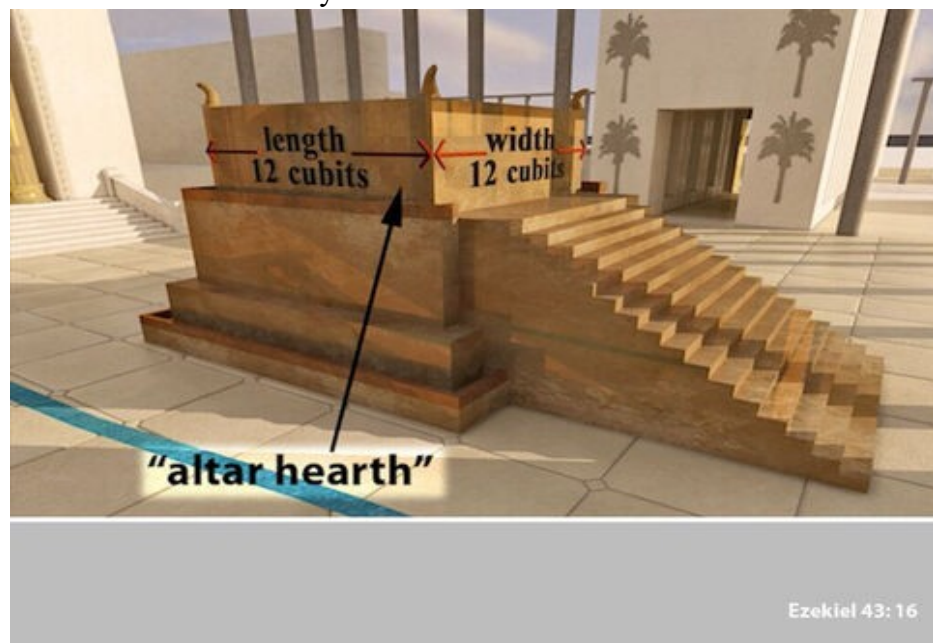
Analysis of Ezekiel 43:13:

- Definition of the Cubit: The text specifies that "**the cubit is a cubit and a handbreadth.**" This suggests that the cubit used for the altar's measurements is longer than the standard cubit, augmented by an additional handbreadth.
- Standard Cubit: Traditionally, a cubit is understood to be approximately 18 inches (1.5 feet), based on the distance from the elbow to the tip of the middle finger, which varied slightly across ancient cultures but is commonly accepted as 18 inches in biblical contexts.
- Handbreadth: A handbreadth (or handspan) is typically considered to be about 4 inches, representing the width of a hand across the palm.
- Total Cubit Length: Adding the handbreadth to the standard cubit, the adjusted cubit would be 18 inches + 4 inches = 22 inches.

This Altar measurement of Ezekiel is 12 cubits by 12 cubits

Ezekiel 43:16 And the altar shall be **twelve cubits long, twelve broad**, square in the four squares thereof.

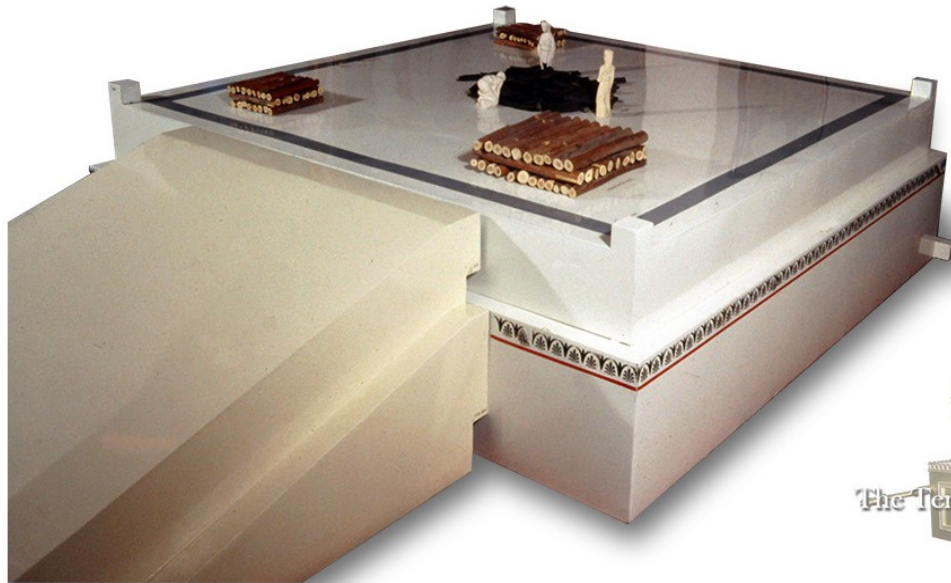
12 cubits by 12 cubits of each cubit being 22 inches each is 264 inches which is 22 feet Each side.



This does not match the measurements that people preparing to build third temple with.

Third Temple Institute says 52 ft as Ezekiel's measurement is 22 ft

Whats also interesting is that the altar they built they claim is stone.



The problem is there is not a grate for the burnt offering if you notice they leave it out.....

They have no brass grate for the meat to rest on to grill in thier picture of thier stone altar.

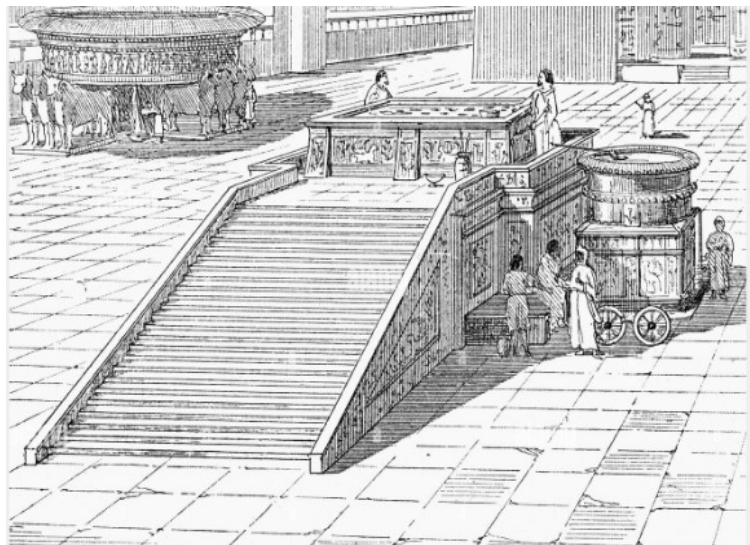


Exodus 27:27 And thou shalt make an altar of shittim wood, five cubits long, and five cubits broad; the altar shall be foursquare: and the height thereof shall be three cubits.

2 And thou shalt make the horns of it upon the four corners thereof: his horns shall be of the same: and thou shalt overlay it with brass.

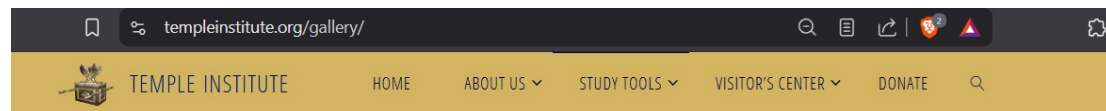
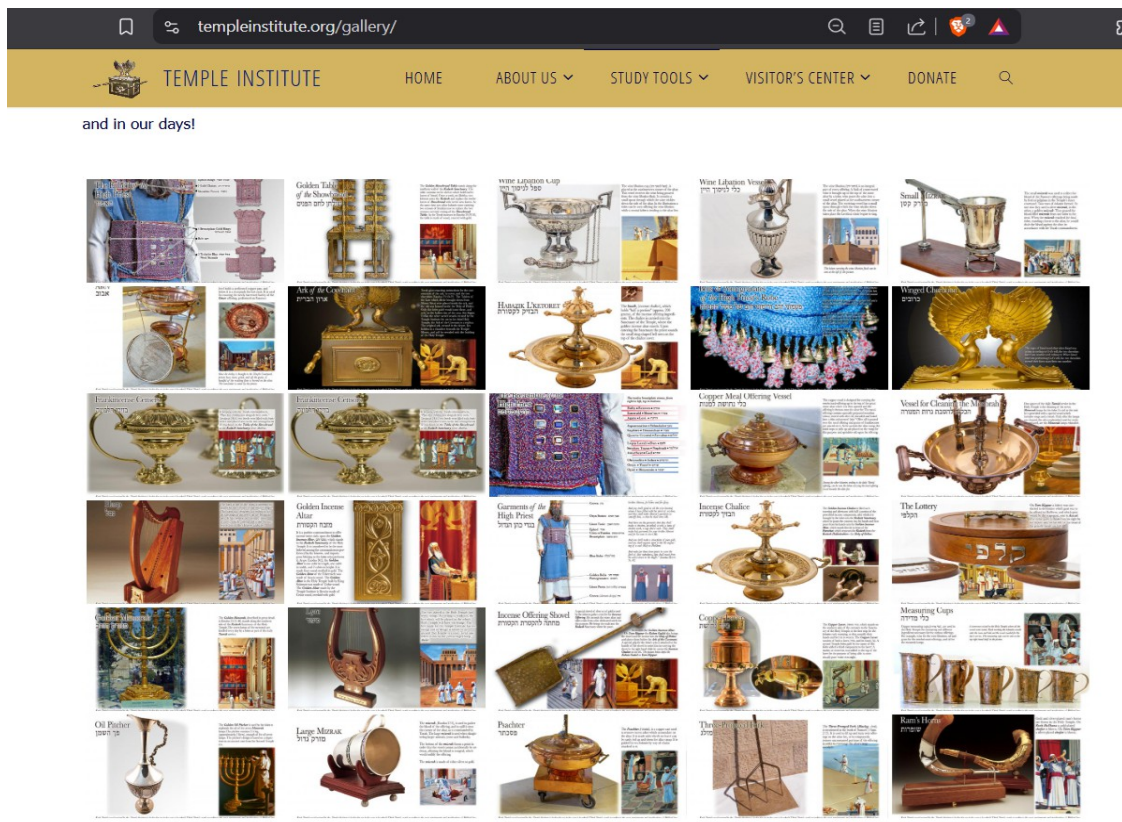
We clearly see that this altar dimensions dont match Ezekiels it dont match what Moses or Solomon did with the altar.

It dont match the gold altar of the messiah where things that are brass will be switched with gold.

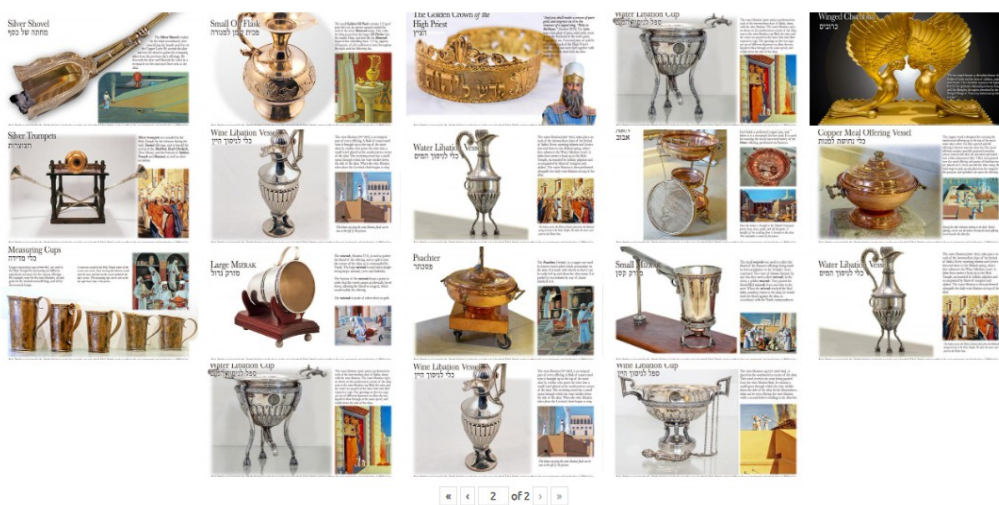


Its very possible that they have the brass altar that rests on top of that stone altar for the burnt offering and they are keeping it from the public to see.

Its very interesting that all thier items gallery they have for the third temple the only one thats left out for everyone to see is the altar of the burnt offering..

In the measuring of the altar and the people thereof who will worship at this third temple.

Its clear the measurement of the people and the altar do not match what is required of by Messiah.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and **the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure** the temple of God, **and the altar,** and **them that worship therein.**

The measuring of the altar proves the third temple is not the messiahs temple and it will be sacked.
