

## Ashamed sun

Those who have been prophesying in the end times all their falsehoods for zionism and rapture and other various wild false prophesies will be exposed as plagues come on them to the point that at the end they deny they are prophets in the end times.

The sun will testify against these false prophets in the end times and be a mirror their shame.

The two prophets Zechariah and Micah warn of these false prophets of the end time which are prophetic foreshadow of the end times two prophets who warn of the same.

Micah a prophet witnesses as one of the first witnesses against these false prophets.

Micah 3:4 Then shall they cry unto the Lord, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.

Micah 3:5 Thus saith the Lord concerning the prophets that make my people err, that bite with their teeth, and cry, Peace; and he that putteth not into their mouths, they even prepare war against him.

Micah 3:6 Therefore night shall be unto you, that ye shall not have a vision; and it shall be dark unto you, that ye shall not divine; and **the sun shall go down over the prophets, and the day shall be dark over them.**

Micah 3:7 Then **shall the seers be ashamed**, and the **diviners confounded**: yea, they shall all cover their lips; for there is no answer of God.

These false prophets will be confounded and shamed on the day of the Lord when the day shall be dark over them which is on the day of the Lord.

Their shame of them being wrong shall hit them when the sun goes black and thier prophesy failed.

Isaiah 24:3 Then **the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed**, when the LORD of hosts shall reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously.

They shall be ashamed and they shall be confounded just as the Sun and the Moon are when the day goes black over them.

The prophet Zechariah is a second witness testifying against these false prophets of end times..

Zech 13:2 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also **I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.**

They will be punished for being false prophets.

Zech 13:3 And it shall come to pass, **that when any shall yet prophesy, then his father and his mother that begat him shall say unto him, Thou shalt not live;** for thou speakest lies in the name of the Lord: and **his father and his mother that begat him shall thrust him through when he prophesieth.**

Zech 13:4 And it shall come to pass in that day, that **the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to deceive:**

The day will testify of this and they wont wear sackclothe to decieve anymore and they will be ashamed as the day of the Lord comes the sun is ashamed and the sun is wearing sackclothe as a testimony.

They will no longer decieve wearing a rough garment of sacklothe themselves for true prophets have spoken wearing sackclothe testifying of the true day of the Lord and its fulfillments.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and **the sun became black as sackcloth of hair,** and the moon became as blood;

but they will speak that they are no prophets denying that they prophesied...

Zech 13:5 But **he shall say, I am no prophet,** I am an husbandman; for man taught me to keep cattle from my youth.

Zech 13:6 And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, **Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.**

Yet their wounds will speak for themselves as the wounds of a false prophet is given to them on the day of the Lord as reward for them being false prophets just like the wounds of the prophets of baal.

This is the two testimonies of Zechariah and Micah as two prophets testifying against these false prophets of the end times to fulfill the law.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.**

Just as foreshadow of the end times where the Lord sends two prophets in sackclothe to testify against these false prophets with the true vision and prophesy.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my **two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

To testify of the day of the Lord and that plagues will come on those who refuse correction from the prophets.

The plagues which will come from the testifying and the prophesying...

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.**

This is he that testifies Christ as one of the three witnesses of this.

Rev 22:18 For **I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:**

The plagues will be prophesied on those by two other witnesses against them thus the law fulfilled in two or three witnesses.

And also testifying that people are cutt off for adding to the prophesy of the book these events.

Rev 22:19 And **if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.**

Rev 22:20 **He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly.** Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

This is three witnesses of two prophets and Christ testifying that the law may be fulfilled.

These are who that testifies surely that He is coming quickly...

Rev 11:7 And **when they shall have finished their testimony,** the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

The day of the Lord the sun will testify of their shame of these false prophets.

The true prophesy will reveal in that day their lies and it will be too late for not listening to the two who are sent to correct them all.

The sun over them will be darkened as their shame of being false prophets is revealed on that day.
