

The unjust

Rev 22:11 **He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.**

He that is unjust in his judgements not judging by the law, leave him be to get his reward for it.

He that is filthy in defiling himself breaking the law, leave him be to get his reward for it.

He that is fulfilling the law and obeying let him remain in that righteous and get his reward.

He who is separated himself let him and he will be rewarded.

Because Christ is about to return and reward people for their obedience or disobedience.

If they refuse to repent let them...

To those who refuse to obey the law and not defile themselves their reward will be according to their deeds they did breaking the law.

To those who obeyed the law in fulfilling the law they will be rewarded in the kingdom as the following verse makes clear.

Rev 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and **my reward** is with me, **to give every man according as his work shall be.**

We see that Christ begins to delegate the rewards for those people.

We see that it follows with the commandments and the law being discussed in verses after.

Rev 22:14 **Blessed are they that do his commandments**, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Rev 22:15 For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

Outside are defiled people like dogs who are filthy.. lawbreakers. and defiled.

And the rest of the mankind leftover after the plagues on Christ return who refuse to repent.

Rev 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues **yet repented not of the works of their hands**, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

Rev 9:21 **Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.**

So we see on His return theres people even after all the signs, plagues and judgements falling on them for their rejecting His law and atonement...

They still refuse and wont repent and they will get their reward for it.

You who are wise will know this this is why it must come to this conclusion.

The wise will understand... that we cant change the outcome of the prophesy, we are warned that they wont repent....
