

## Sixth bowl

The prophesy of the sixth bowl is to plague the river euphrates with drought so that the ground armies can cross the euphrates that are coming in from the fifth and sixth trumpet.

The plagues are prophesied for 1260 days.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they **shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

The end of the prophesying of the sixth plague is latter in the 1260 days and occurs after rains have already been stopped for 1110 days till the fifth trumpet which leaves 150 days left of the tribulation.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, **that it rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues**, as often as they will.

The rains have been stopped and the river euphrates will have the bowl plague poured out on it.

Rev 16:12 And the **sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates**; and the **water thereof was dried up**, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

This is possible that the fullness of the river euphrates drying up in its entirety by the rains being stopped for the prior 1110 days and even unto the day of the Lord.

Fifth trumpet before this means there is only five months left from it until the end of the 1260 days.

Rev 9:10 And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to **hurt men five months**.

Rev 9:5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented **five months**: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.

At the end of those 5 months is when the battle of armegaddon occurs.

This prepares the way for those 200 million man army to cross from the sixth trumpet prior.

The armies are gathering for armegadon and Christ is going to use the kings of the east as a vessel of destruction on the beasts armies on that final day.

Rev 16:13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

Rev 16:14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, **which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty**.

This bowl after the trumpet is how those 200 million man armies come accross to kill 1/3 the earth.

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

Rev 9:14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels **which are bound in the great river Euphrates.**

Rev 9:15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, **for to slay the third part of men.**

Rev 9:16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

They were bound at the river euphrates not able to cross the river with the 200 million man armies until the river was fully dried which occurs by the time of the sixth bowl.

Event he exact time of the rain stopping and the river drying up is known that it will fulfill latter for the purpose of the Lord to bring accross those armies that He will use against the beast.

Rev 16:12 And **the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates;** and the water thereof was dried up, that **the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.**

This is why the river is dried up that these armies are able to come invading into the middle east against the beast.

Rains are stopped and the river dries.
