

Mountains flee

The prophesy of the day of the Lord where the people flee to hide in caves will be revealed in this.

The points made in the prophesy are not just about the people hiding in bunkers and caves but it goes further to show how God foreknows what all they will try to do on His return.

The begining of this is on the day of the Lord at the Resurrection.

The great earthquake from the Resurrection occurs and the ground begins to split.

Rev 11:11 And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and **they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.**

This is the Resurrection.

Rev 11:13 And **the same hour was there a great earthquake**, and the tenth part of the city fell, and **in the earthquake** were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

This great earthquake is the same time of the Resurrection why it says the same hour.

Rev 16:18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a **great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.**

Rev 16:19 And **the great city was divided into three parts**, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

Rev 16:20 And every island fled away, and **the mountains were not found.**

This is very important to take note that at this great earthquake the city of Jerusalem is broken and split into three parts and the mountains are not found. This will become clear latter.

This is the prophesy where Jerusalem has a rift between mount of olives from the north and south.

This is at the time of the great earthquake.

Zech 14:4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the **mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.**

Zech 14:5 And **ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah** king of Judah: and the Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.

6 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark:

Make note here we will go into the fleeing to the mountains latter in this.

The day of the Lord is when this occurs and the great earthquake is seen here also.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, **there was a great earthquake;** and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

Rev 6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

Rev 6:14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and **every mountain and island were moved out of their places.**

We see every mountain moved out of their places.. remmeber this again for latter.

Rev 6:15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, **hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;**

We see they flee to hide into the mountains and say to the mountains rocks to fall on them.

Rev 6:16 And said to **the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us** from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Rev 6:17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and **who shall be able to stand?**

The who shall be able to stand reference is part of this prophesy told of the old prophets.

What happens here is we see the old testament prophets being fulfilled.

On the day of the Lord they go to hide in the mountains and caves.

Isa 2:19 And **they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth,** for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of his majesty, **when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.**

He rises and shakes the earth with a great earthquake.

Isa 2:20 In that day a man shall cast his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which they made each one for himself to worship, to the moles and to the bats;

They will try to hide thier idols in the caves.

Isa 2:21 **To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks,** for fear of the Lord, and for the glory of his majesty, **when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.**

They go and flee to hide into the mountains and caves when He comes.

Christ had two witnesses with him put to death to testify of this day that they will cry out

Luke 23:30 Then shall **they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us.**

Luke 23:31 For if they **do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the dry?**

Luke 23:32 And there were also **two other, malefactors, led with him to be put to death.**

This is done that the matter of the law may be fulfilled.

Deut 19:15 One witness shall not rise up against a man for any iniquity, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: **at the mouth of two witnesses**, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established.

This is the foreshadow of the prophesy of the end times mountains falling on them.

The Lord has led two to be put to death with Him in his manner in the end who testify of this prophesy.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto **my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy** a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The end of that prophesy has dry trees from droughts world wide after the 1260 days.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that **it rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

This is after the 1260 days of the prophesy where the trees are dry in Christs warning about them fleeing and crying out fall on us.

This is day of the Resurrection that two were put to death like Christ is seen with earthquake.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because **these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.**

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet**; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

The hour of that great earthquake where they begin to flee and run and hide to the mountains crying out fall on us...

They run and hide at that hour but what occurs... The mountains flee when they run to the mountains....

Great earthquake they flee to the mountains.

Zech 14:5 And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the Lord my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.

When they flee to the caves and mountains what happens to them? They die from the mountains.

The Lord flattens the mountains on them.

Rev 6:14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

The mountains are moved out of thier places....

Rev 16:20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

The mountains are not found...because they are leveled.

The mountains they run too are leveled from Geba to Rimmon the mountains of Israel.

Zech 14:10 All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

The mountains are leveled like mountains of hot wax..

Micah 1:3 For, behold, the Lord cometh forth out of his place, and will come down, and tread upon the high places of the earth.

Micah 1:4 And the mountains shall be molten under him, and the valleys shall be cleft, as wax before the fire, and as the waters that are poured down a steep place.

The earth quakes in trembling and mountains melt like wax going flat....

Psalm 97:4 His lightnings enlightened the world: the earth saw, and trembled.

Psalm 97:5 The hills melted like wax at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.

The mountains quake and melt and they say who can but stand?

Nahum 1:5 The mountains quake at him, and the hills melt, and the earth is burned at his presence, yea, the world, and all that dwell therein.

Nahum 1:6 Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him.

This is the same prophesy where they cry on the rocks and the mountains to fall on them...

Rev 6:16 And said to **the mountains and rocks, Fall on us**, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Rev 6:17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and **who shall be able to stand?**

Who is able to stand during that great earthquake in that quake?

Everyone will be brought to their knees...

Isaiah 40:3 The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

Isaiah 40:4 Every valley shall be exalted, and **every mountain and hill shall be made low**: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain:

Isaiah 40:5 And the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it.

The running and hiding to the mountains of them fleeing will end with them perishing from the mountains and rocks falling on them covering them.

The mountain will fall on them and cover them and the rocks will fall on them.

Rev 6:16 And said to **the mountains and rocks, Fall on us**, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

as Christ warned.

Luke 23:30 Then shall **they begin to say to the mountains, Fall on us; and to the hills, Cover us.**

The mountains and the rocks covering them as they call out for them to fall on them...

Hosea 10:8 The high places also of Aven, the sin of Israel, shall be destroyed: the thorn and the thistle shall come up on their altars; **and they shall say to the mountains, Cover us; and to the hills, Fall on us.**

everyone is brought to their knees in that earth quake...

Rev 6:17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and **who shall be able to stand?**

Why can they not stand? Because the great earthquake.

They will have their knees bent not being able to stand on that day.

Nahum 1:6 **Who can stand before his indignation?** and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him.

Very knee shall bow on that day even the mountains will bow before Him.

Habakkuk 3:6 He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting **mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills did bow:** his ways are everlasting.

“As I sit in darkness, I talk but only hear echos. like the cave of Elijah I sit in sheol. There is no light in the days of darkness. The mountains tremble in fear and don't want to hide the inhabitants. Yes even the mountains flee from Him on that day. Their highness is brought low and the mountains will bow before him on that terrible day.”

The mountains will fall and crush and kill those who run tot hem on the day to hide.

The mountains, and rocks will cover them.

The mountains flee
