

Ishmael's seed

The prophetic promise of Ishmael is found in the end times prophecy.

Many neglect to understand the blessing of Abraham's son Isaac was not the only blessing given by God.

The promise of the Messiah inheritance came to Isaac only yes, but this isn't the only blessing given by God and Ishmael was blessed by God with a blessing and promise also.

This promise is found to be fulfilled in the end times for sons of Ishmael

Genesis 17:18 And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee!

Genesis 17:19 And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

Genesis 17:20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will **make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.** will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.

Genesis 17:22 And he left off talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.

Genesis 17:23 And **Abraham took Ishmael his son**, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and **circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day**, as God had said unto him.

Genesis 17:25 And Ishmael his son was thirteen years old, when **he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin.**

Genesis 17:26 In the selfsame day was Abraham circumcised, and **Ishmael his son.**

We see that Abraham was told promises about Ishmael being made a great nation and make him fruitful and multiply him exceedingly and making him have 12 princes.. just like the twelve sons of Israel.

Genesis 17:20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; **twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.** will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.

This promise was intended for the the will of the Lord to be done in the end times.

Now look what was said about the Child in further text about his blessings and promise from God.

Genesis 21:9 And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking.

Genesis 21:10 Wherefore she said unto Abraham, Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, even with Isaac.

Genesis 21:11 And the thing was very grievous in Abraham's sight because of his son.

So the bondwoman and Ishmael were cast out from the house of Abraham so they wouldnt inherit the lineage promise of Issac.

But it goes further... does it mean that Ishmaels blessing was gone?

It grieved Abraham about his love for his son Ishmael.

Genesis 12:12 And **God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad**, and because of thy bondwoman; **in all that Sarah hath said unto thee**, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.

He repeats to Abraham not to be grieved because also He will make Ishmael a great nation.

Genesis 12:13 And also of the son of the bondwoman **will I make a nation**, because he is thy seed.

We see again that yes Hagar was sent out but what occurred?

Genesis 21:14 And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave it unto Hagar, putting it on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

Genesis 21:15 And the water was spent in the bottle, and she cast the child under one of the shrubs.

Genesis 21:16 And she went, and sat her down over against him a good way off, as it were a bow shot: for **she said, Let me not see the death of the child. And she sat over against him, and lift up her voice, and wept.**

Genesis 21:17 And **God heard the voice of the lad**; and **the angel of God called to Hagar out of heaven**, and said unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? **fear not; for God hath heard the voice of the lad where he is.**

She cries out and the angel of the Lord says fear not for God has heard the voice of the lad...

He repeats the blessing and promise of the child Ishmael..

Genesis 21:18 Arise, **lift up the lad, and hold him in thine hand; for I will make him a great nation.**

So then God opens her eyes to see... so we see God is working with her lineage...

Genesis 21:19 And **God opened her eyes**, and she saw a well of water; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the lad drink.

Genesis 21:20 And **God was with the lad**; and he grew, and dwelt in the wilderness, and became an archer.

God was with Ishamel for the blessing....

Going back to the child Ishmaels birth...and the blessing...

Genesis 16:6 But Abram said unto Sarai, Behold, thy maid is in thine hand; do to her as it pleaseth thee. And when Sarai dealt hardly with her, she fled from her face.

Genesis 16:7 And **the angel of the Lord found her** by a fountain of water in the wilderness, by the fountain in the way to Shur.

Angel of the Lord found hagar prior and said to her this...

Genesis 16:8 And **he said, Hagar, Sarai's maid, whence camest thou?** and whither wilt thou go? And she said, I flee from the face of my mistress Sarai.

Genesis 16:9 And **the angel of the Lord said unto her**, Return to thy mistress, and submit thyself under her hands.

He tells her to go back to the house of Abraham.

Genesis 16:10 And **the angel of the Lord said unto her, I will multiply thy seed exceedingly, that it shall not be numbered for multitude.**

The Lord said to her through the angel of the Lord that through ishmael his seed will be multiplied exceedingly that it wont be able to be numbered. Just like the blessing of Issaac.

Gen 16:11 And the angel of the Lord said unto her, Behold, thou art with child and shalt bear a son, and **shalt call his name Ishmael**; because the Lord hath heard thy affliction.

The Lord named Ishmael like He named Israel.

The promise and the blessings didnt get revoked...

Genesis 16:12 And **he will be a wild man**; his hand will be against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren.

He will be a wild man and his hand will be against every man and every mans hand will be against him and he will dwell in the presence of all the people.

Genesis 16:13 And she called the name of the Lord that spake unto her, Thou God seest me: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me?

Abram or Abraham names him according to the will of God.

Genesis 16:15 And Hagar bare Abram a son: and Abram called his son's name, which **Hagar bare, Ishmael**.

Genesis 16:16 And Abram was fourscore and six years old, when **Hagar bare Ishmael to Abram**.

Now with this said and these promises its clear to note some things...

The world tends to lead towards bias of the zionist state narratives that Muslims are in no way intitled to things and that they are the only heirs of promises...

The problem is Zionists promise of the seed of Abraham came through Christ.

Theres no inheritance for them.

On the contrary... Ishmael had twelve princes with blessings and promise that did continue...

1 Chron 1:29 These are their generations: The firstborn of Ishmael, Nebaioth; then **Kedar**, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

1 Chron1:30 Mishma, and Dumah, Massa, Hadad, and Tema,

1 Chron 1:31 Jetur, Naphish, and Kedemah. These are the sons of Ishmael.

1 Chron 1:32 Now the sons of Keturah, Abraham's concubine: she bare Zimran, and Jokshan, and Medan, and Midian, and Ishbak, and Shuah. And the sons of Jokshan; Sheba, and Dedan.

1Chron 1:33 And the sons of Midian; Ephah, and Ephher, and Henoah, and Abida, and Eldaah. All these are the sons of Keturah.

We see the twelve sons of Ishmael.

And like the promise of Christ through Abraham became the seed out of one of the twelve tribes.

The Messiah came through Judah one of the lineages of the promise of the Messiah.

Genesis 49: All these are the twelve tribes of Israel: and this is it that their father spake unto them, and blessed them; every one according to his blessing he blessed them.

Genesis 49:8 Judah, thou art he whom thy brethren shall praise: thy hand shall be in the neck of thine enemies; thy father's children shall bow down before thee.

Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

The promise of the scepter of the Messiah through Judah is given out of one of the twelve sons.

So what is given to the promise out of this? The kingdom of God a Great Nation.

The blessing of Abraham

Gen 12:12 **And I will make of thee a great nation**, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

The seed of Issaac

Romans 9:7 Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, are they all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

Gal 3:16 Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

Seed of Abraham and Isaac is the Messiah.

This kingdom of God is the great nation which is called the Great Mountain.

Mountains are prophetic terms for nations.

Daniel 2:35 Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image **became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.**

So what about the blessing and promise of Ishmael's twelve sons?

The Lord promised Ishmael also would have twelve princes like the twelve princes of Israel and that they would become a great nation....

Genesis 17:20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; **twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.** will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.

So who came out of that twelve?

Out of the Twelve Sons of Ishmael came Kedar the second son...

1 Chron 1:29 These are their generations: The firstborn of Ishmael, Nebaioth; then **Kedar**, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

What was the promise out of those twelve sons if it wasn't the messiah? And they become a great nation??

Genesis 25:13 And these are **the names of the sons of Ishmael**, by their names, according to their generations: the firstborn of Ishmael, Nebajoth; and **Kedar**, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

Yes, according to Islamic tradition, Muhammad is considered a descendant of Ishmael, the son of Abraham, through the Hashem tribe which is from Kedar.

The Jordanians at the south Jordan in the land of Edom of Petra are the hashemites and are where Mohamed's clan had come.

The Hashemite kingdom of Jordan is heirs of this clan.

The Hashemites also House of Hashim, are the royal family of Jordan,

The Banu Hashim claim to trace their ancestry from Hashim ibn Abd Manaf (died c. 497 AD), the great-grandfather of Muhammad

According to Islamic tradition, Muhammad is a descendant of Ishmael, the son of Abraham, through the Hashem tribe, and his lineage is traced back to Ishmael through his **son Kedar**, then to Adnan, and then to the Musta'riba, and finally to the Quraysh.

Kedar is the land in the valley of Petra Jordan in Edom.

The bible's Antichrist will not be able to overthrow the kingdom of Jordan because it's directly heir to the promises of Ishmael.

Dan 11:41 He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: **but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.**

This is the location where the Church is at hosted for the last 42 months of End times.

This is the prophesy of the Church who exodus to Jordan during the end times and it contains the location of the descendants of Ishmael a place where God has prepared.

Revelation 12:6 And **the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God**, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

The Remnant of Church exodus to the wilderness of Petra for the last 42 months.

This is found in the prophesy of Isaiah in the location of the land where the sons of Ishmael are.

Isaiah 42:10 Sing unto the Lord a new song, and his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.

Isaiah 42:11 **Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up their voice, the villages that Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.**

We see the location where Kedar did inhabit which is the Petra rock mountains of Edom Jordan.

We know this because Genesis tell us.

Genesis 25:13 And these are **the names of the sons of Ishmael**, by their names, according to their generations: the firstborn of Ishmael, Nebajoth; and **Kedar**, and Adbeel, and Mibsam,

We see the second born of Ishmael is Kedar.

So what are we looking at with the promise of Ishmael and his seed?

If the seed of Issac is Christ the Messiah out of the twelve princes..

Then the seed of Ishmael out of the twelve princes is the Antichrist and his kingdom for the end.

Islam cannot be overthrown by men. Its given to them as their blessing theyll become a great nation and that seed of Ishmael is multiplying and spreading thoroughout the earth.

Genesis 16:12 And **he will be a wild man; his hand will be against every man, and every man's hand against him; and he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren.**

His hand will be against every man and every mans hand will be against .

Hewill dwell in the presence of all the people.

They are the vessels chosen to be used in the end times judgement and they will be taking rule from Jerusalem for those 42 months.
