

Temple ark.

The time of Solomon and the time of David are prophetic allegory of the end times.

This is two witnesses of the events of the end that were foreshadowed through Solomon and David.

During the time of Solomon the temple of God was filled with power and there was no Ark that left out for war.

Looking to the first account we see this is prophetic foreshadow of the 1260 days of end times.

1 kings 8:3 And all the elders of Israel came, and the priests took up the ark.

4 And they brought up the ark of the LORD, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the holy vessels that were in the tabernacle, even those did the priests and the Levites bring up.

5 And king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel, that were assembled unto him, were with him before the ark, sacrificing sheep and oxen, that could not be told nor numbered for multitude.

6 And the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, into the oracle of the house, to the most holy place, even under the wings of the cherubims.

7 For the cherubims spread forth their two wings over the place of the ark, and the cherubims covered the ark and the staves thereof above.

8 And they drew out the staves, that the ends of the staves were seen out in the holy place before the oracle, and they were not seen without: and there they are unto this day.

9 There was nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt.

10 And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD, 11 So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.

This is what happened when the power filled the temple of God during Solomon, the seven priests with trumpets set the ark in the temple of God and went outside and nobody was allowed to enter after.

The Ark during the life of Solomon did not come out to go to war.

The account of Solomons Temple being filled with the power of God.

2 chronicle 5:11 And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place: (for all the priests that were present were sanctified, and did not then wait by course:

12 Also the Levites which were the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, being arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:)

13 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD;

14 So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

Now looking to the account of David going out to war.

1 Chron 15:1 And David made him houses in the city of David, and **prepared a place for the ark of God, and pitched for it a tent.**

1 Chron 15:3 And David gathered all Israel together to Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the Lord unto his place, which he had prepared for it.

So the Ark was placed in its tabernacle then the ark was revealed to go to war in seige of Rabbah

2 Samuel 11:1 And it came to pass, after the year was expired, **at the time when kings go forth to battle, that David** sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and **besieged Rabbah**. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

The Ark was in the battle field with the soldiers sent out...

2 Samuel 11:11 And Uriah said unto David, **The ark, and Israel, and Judah, abide in tents;** and my lord Joab, and the servants of my lord, are encamped in the open fields; shall I then go into mine house, to eat and to drink, and to lie with my wife? as thou livest, and as thy soul liveth, I will not do this thing.

This is David sending out the Ark to siege Rabbah a prophetic sieging of Jerusalem from beast.

So we see that during Solomon the Ark was in the temple of God and it was filled with power blowing with seven trumpets and during the time of David the Ark was sent out into the war out of the tabernacle.

This is seen in the prophecy of the end times.

The temple of God in heaven will have the ark prepared in it and the seven angels with seven trumpets .

These seven angels with seven trumpets exit the temple of God and it is be filled with the power of God and closed until after the judgements.

After the 1260 days filled with power and seven trumpets have sounded the temple of God in heaven will then be opened and the ark will be revealed.

Seven angels with the seven trumpets and bowls leave temple and it fills with power.

Rev 8:2 And I saw **the seven angels** which stood before God; and to them were **given seven trumpets.**

Rev 8:6 And **the seven angels which had the seven trumpets** prepared themselves to sound

Seven Angels leave and then it closes.

Rev 16:1 And I heard a great voice **out of the temple** saying to **the seven angels, Go your ways,** and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth.

Then you see the Angels leaving with seven trumpets and temple of God filling with power.

Rev 15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, **the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:**

6 And the **seven angels came out of the temple**, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.

7 And one of the four beasts **gave unto the seven angels** seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever.

8 And **the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.**

So just like the days of Solomon. The temple God is filled with power which holds the Ark in heaven (tabernacle of the testimony).

The temple of God is then closed from the power until the seven angels going out with the seven trumpets is completed which is the 1260 days of the great tribulation.

When the 1260 days of Judgements finished and temple opens back up read for war with the beast.

So we see the seventh trumpet sound to finish.

Rev 11:15 And **the seventh angel sounded;** and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Then we see the seventh trumpets finished and the temple of God open and the Ark is seen.

Rev 11:19 And **the temple of God was opened in heaven**, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Temple of God in heaven filled with power for 1260 days and the temple of God on earth with its lampstands filled with power for 1260 days on earth as it is in heaven.

Rev 11:3 And **I will give power unto my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

This is the same time of the prophesy.

Rev 15: 8 And **the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power**; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

So we see at the two signs of Solomon and David with the ark and temple are foreshadows of the end times.

First like the days of Solomon during the time the temple of God is filled with power the ark doesnt go out to war and seven trumpets are sounded.

Second is like the days of David during war the Ark was brought out of tabernacle.

Christ is the Davidic King coming out with the Ark for the war to siege jerusalem like Rabbah.

Rev 22:16 I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. **I am the root and the offspring of David**, and the bright and morning star.

You see the same time the temple opens at the seventh trumpet..

Rev 19:11 And **I saw heaven opened**, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and **make war**.

Christs armies begin to make war against the beast with the Ark.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

The foreshadow of the Messiah is found in of days of Solomon and David and the Ark.
