

Wild grapes.

Jerusalem Jerusalem you were to bring forth grapes but brought forth wild grapes.

Matt 21:33 Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and **hedged it round about**, and **digged a winepress in it**, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and **went into a far country**:

34 And when the time of the fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the fruits of it.

35 And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another.

36 Again, he sent other servants more than the first: and they did unto them likewise.

37 But last of all **he sent unto them his son**, saying, **They will reverence my son**.

38 But when the husbandmen **saw the son**, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance.

39 And they caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard, and slew him.

40 When the lord therefore of the vineyard cometh, what will he do unto those husbandmen?

41 They say unto him, **He will miserably destroy those wicked men**, and will let out his vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons.

These wicked men are wild grapes of the vineyard.

Isaiah 5:1-6 (KJV) 1 Now will I sing to my wellbeloved a song of my beloved **touching his vineyard**. My wellbeloved hath a vineyard in a very fruitful hill:

2 And **he fenced it**, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also **made a winepress therein**: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and **it brought forth wild grapes**.

3 And now, **O inhabitants of Jerusalem**, and men of Judah, judge, I pray you, betwixt me and my vineyard.

4 What could have been done more to my vineyard, that I have not done in it? wherefore, when I looked that it should bring forth grapes, **brought it forth wild grapes?**

5 And now go to; I will tell you what I will do to my vineyard: **I will take away the hedge thereof**, and it shall be eaten up; and **break down the wall thereof**, and **it shall be trodden down**:

6 And I will lay it waste: it shall not be pruned, nor digged; but there shall come up briars and thorns: I will also command the clouds that **they rain no rain upon it**.

Hear now O Jerusalem.

You are the wild grapes that will be trodden down in the winepress by the Heathens coming.

We are going to collect the good grapes to take with us before the feet of the trodders come.

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; **for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months.**

And again its said... you are to Exodus with us when the harvest is ready.

Luke 21:20 And **when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies**, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.

21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.

Luke 21:24 (KJV) And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.

Because the trodders will be given the city and the rains will be withheld 42 months.

Isaiah 5:6 And I will lay it waste: it shall not be pruned, nor digged; but there shall come up **briers and thorns**: I will also command the clouds that **they rain no rain upon it.**

Here is the prophesy.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and **they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

And the rains will be withheld that it rain not on these grapes of the earth and briers and thorns who take over.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, **that it rain not in the days of their prophecy**: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Then after the 1260 days we will put forth the sickle to the harvest of the grapes of the earth.

The briers and thorns will come up from the dust without rain withered thorns and weeds.

Rev 14:14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in **his hand a sharp sickle.**

Rev 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and **gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.**

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into **the great winepress of the wrath of God.**

This is the prophesy of the end times grapes. Wild grapes.
