

Martyrs march

I saw in the vision multitudes walking through the rift in the mount of olive. Those leading the procession were clothed in white and crowned in glory with date palm branches in their hands..they sang hosanna in the highest. The procession of the saints went through to the east gate to the princes gate where they laid their date palm branches before the white horse of Christ coming into the princes gate. Just like when He rode in on an ass. This is the vision I saw of the Day of the Lord.

Christ the lion of Judah is foretold in Genesis 49 about riding on an colt.

Genesis 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

This is what was seen when Christ first came to Jerusalem riding on an ass.

Matt 21:5 Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and **sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.**

6 And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them,

7 And **brought the ass, and the colt**, and put on them their clothes, and **they set him thereon.**

8 And **a very great multitude** spread their garments in the way; **others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way.**

9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.

10 And when he was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this?

Here we see what was to be fulfilled spoken of Him.

John 12:13 **Took branches of palm trees**, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

14 And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,

15 Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.

This was fulfilled during the first Entry of Christ into Jerusalem.

Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

This is foreshadow of the second coming of Christ.

The Second coming of Christ the procession into Jerusalem goes through the Rift of the Mount of Olive into the East gate.

Zech 14:3 Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

Those leading the procession are the Martyrs of Christ with their date palm branches.

This is the great multitude with palms just like the first coming of Christ.

John 12:8 And **a very great multitude** spread their garments in the way; **others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way.**

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, **a great multitude**, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and **palms in their hands;**

The likeness of Christ riding in on a colt the first coming is reflected in Christ second coming.

He is riding in on a white horse.

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and **behold a white horse;** and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and **make war.**

The fulfillment of Zechariah 14 is seen here.

Zech 14:3 Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

Here is Christ fighting the nations on the way to Jerusalem.

Rev 19:14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Rev 19:19 And **I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies**, gathered together to make **war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.**

Thus to be fulfilled He will be clothed in a vesture dipped in blood from treading the beasts army.

Genesis 49:11 Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; **he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:**

Rev 19:13 And **he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood:** and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and **he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.**

Taking back the city of Jerusalem from the beast and entering her gates.

This is the procession of the Martyrs with Christ re-entering Jerusalem from the east.
