Greetings

با درود

in this very important EID al adha message

i present to you the story of abraham who went to sacrifice his son

in the scriptures which muslims celebrate were long told before mohamed

about the significance of the lamb that was provided by the LORD

in the scriptures muslims accept john the baptist as a prophet

and in the scriptures it contain the history what john what he said about Yeshua

and how he was the lamb.

The story of abraham begins with abraham taking the wood up to the mountain

to sacrifice his son and on behalf of abraham in his faith

God provides a lamb to be sacrificed

thus sparing his son from being sacrificed

which made abraham very glad

in the book of john chapter 1:29

john the baptist saw yeshua coming and he said in verse 29

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John is referencing the story of abraham

and how Christ Jesus would be in the likeness of the lamb provided for abraham

abraham instead of his son dying ,

God placed a lamb to die on his behalf

and that is what made abraham glad

jesus when he goes into the story about abraham and talks to the jews he says in verse john 8:54
55 56

Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:

Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.

Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.

If jesus was not sacrificed as a lamb on behalf of others to be spared

these statements would not have been made

john the prophet would not declared jesus to be the lamb

there would thus remain no sacrifice for others and no reason for jesus to say that abraham rejoiced to see his day

because christ was sacrificed on the cross that others would be spared thus becoming the lamb who was slain and sacrificed for others sins.

This EID al adha message should go deep into questioning of Islam

why you are celebrate a sacrifice that bares no hold for redemption

unless its true that Yeshua is the Lamb of God

who was slain and died on the cross in your place

to die in your place that way that you may rejoice

that he offered a lamb that on your behalf you would be spared.
