

King over fire.

Shiloh comes in Revelation as a King over fire with Staff in hand sheparding man.

Genesis 49: The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, **until Shiloh come**; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

The letters of SHILOH are found in Shin Yad Lamed and Hey.

Shin,

In the Sefer Yetzirah the letter Shin is King over Fire

Lamed,

The name of the letter לָמַד (lamed) comes from its shape – מַלְמַד הַבָּקָר (malmad habakar) cattle prod or a shepherd's staff. Malmad habakar was a tool used in Biblical times. It was a piece of wood that was shaped like the letter lamed. The shepherd or farmer used it to direct his animals, as if he was מְלַמֵּד (melamed) teaching the animals the correct way to go.

Hey,

The original pictograph for this letter is a man standing with his arms raised up.

These pictographic images tell a story in the word Shiloh.



Man his staff in his hand and king over fire.

Now this wouldnt be as interesting if this was coincidental but the verses in this context contain this story as well on Christs return.

He has the name SHILOH on his crown . The word NAME means authority.

Rev 19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and **he had a name written**, that no man knew, but he himself.

In the verses talking about His return emediately following we see the same images of pictograms.

Here is Christ with his Staff and Sceptor a Ron of Iron.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and **he shall rule them with a rod of iron:** and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Here is Christ with the power as a king over the lake of Fire.

Rev 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. **These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone**

Here is Christ declaaring on His return he will have power over the fire

Matt 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

40 As therefore the tares are gathered and **burned in the fire**; so shall it be in the end of this world.

41 The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

42 And **shall cast them into a furnace of fire:** there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

So we see Christ with his rod in his hand throwing people into the lake of fire as a King over the lake of fire...

The authority he has is is the King over fire with his rod in his hand.

This is literally letter for letter the pictograms of the word shiloh in paleo hebrew.

Christ is Shiloh
