This prince the beast exalts himself against is Yeshua Messiah who has not yet been crowned King of Kings until after the seventh trumpet.

Dan 8:25 And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: **he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes;** but he shall be broken without hand.

Yeshua is prince of the kings of the earth according to the Revelation.

Rev 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the **prince of the kings of the earth.** Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

You see now in reference that Yeshua is said to be prince of the kings of the earth.

Princes are to become kings latter.

The seventh trumpet declares the kingdoms of the earth become Christs kingdom.

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, **The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord,** and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

The voices in heaven at that time declare Yeshua has become King over all kingdoms of the earth.

The elders who are to be kings over the earth with Christ to rule cast their crowns at His feet.

Rev 4:10 The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and **cast their crowns before the throne,** saying,

The elders cast their crowns at His feet and he returns with a head with many crowns on it with His authority of the King of kings and Lord of lords.

He's seen with these many crowns on His head making him King of kings.

Rev 19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on **his head were many crowns;** and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

He's the King of kings subdueing the nations.

Rev 19: 16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **King Of Kings,** And Lord Of Lords.

Here is the beast and kings of earth rising up against Christ previously discussed in Daniel.

Rev 16: 13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which **go forth unto the kings of the earth** and of the whole world, **to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.**

16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.

The beast gathers the kings of the earth to fight Christ as the King of kings.

Rev 19:19 And **I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him** that sat on the horse, and against his army.

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were **cast alive into a lake of fire burning** with brimstone.

Beast kingdom taken cast alive in burning fire.

Dan 7: 11 I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld even till the **beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.**

The Kingdom with no end over all kings of the world.

Dan 7: 13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

14 And **there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him:** his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and **his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.**

The kingdom of Christ has no end after subduing the nations on His return.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it **he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron:** and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

He smites the nation lead by the beast and rules the nations with a rod of iron.

The beasts kingdom of the world is taken from him by Christ.

Dan 7: 26 But the judgment shall sit, and **they shall take away his dominion,** to consume and to destroy it unto the end.

27 And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and **all dominions shall serve and obey him.**

The kingdoms of the world will be taken from the beast and given to the saints and ruled by Christ.

This is the prophesy of the beast exalting himself against the prince of princes.
