

The bowls.

The altar before the throne of God is where the incense would be offered up for the prayers of the people.

Rev 8:3 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it **with the prayers of all saints** upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

In the temple these prayers of ours are put up on behalf of the people with the bowls of incense.

Rev 5:8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and **golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.**

This incense on the altar are the prayers going up and put into the bowls. The word for vial is bowls.

The Seven Angels with the Seven Trumpets are given Seven Bowls from the Altar.

Rev 16:7 And one of the four beasts **gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials** full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever.

These seven vials are poured out on the earth of the plagues.

Rev 16:1 And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying **to the seven angels**, Go your ways, and **pour out the vials** of the wrath of God upon the earth.



Here is the seven angels with the bowls pouring out from the prophets prayers for the wrath and judgements for 1260 days.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.



The prophet is the lampstand.

Rev 11:4 These are the two olive trees, and **the two candlesticks** standing before the God of the earth.

The lampstand has seven bowls.

Exodus 25:32 And six branches shall come out of the sides of it; three branches of the candlestick out of the one side, and three branches of the candlestick out of the other side:



33 **Three bowls** made like unto almonds, with a knop and a flower in one branch; and **three bowls** made like almonds in the other branch, with a knop and a flower: so in the six branches that come out of the candlestick.

This lampstand has the power over the plagues in the bowls.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and **to smite the earth with all plagues**, as often as they will.

The prayer of the prophet goes to the Altar and the bowl are poured out by the angel.

The prophet has the power prophesied on earth and its confirmed in heaven by the Angel.

This is shown in Ezekiel and the last days.

Ezekiel prophesies on earth and the Angel in heaven confirms.

Ezekiel 39:17 And, **thou son of man, thus saith the Lord God; Speak unto every feathered fowl**, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.

Here is the angel confirming the same account after the prophet prophesied it.

Revelation 19:17 And **I saw an angel** standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, **saying to all the fowls** that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

The seven bowls will be prophesied over earth during the 1260 days.
