John saw the feet of him...

John 1:27 He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.

His feet John said he was unworthy to lose the sandals of.

Matt 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: **he shall baptize** you with the Holy Ghost, and **with fire**:

Matt 3:12 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but **he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire**

Matt 14:24 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary.

Matt 14:25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, **walking on the sea**.

Christ walked on the FIRE in the furnace.

Dan 3:24 Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the **midst of the fire**? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

Dan 3:25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, **walking in the midst of the fire**, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like **the Son of God**.

His feet are like burnished bronze capable of standing in the fire.

Rev 1:15 And **his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace**; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

Christ again is said to have feet like polished bronze.

Rev 2:18 to the angel of the church in Thyatira write: These are the words of the Son of God, whose eyes are like a blazing fire and **whose feet are like polished bronze**.

He walks on the lake of fire baptising those alive into the lake of fire.

Rev 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. **These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.**

At the end of the 1000 years all will be brought back alive who are dead to be judged.

They will then be baptised alive in the lake of fire who are not written in his book.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Rev 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life **was cast into the lake of fire.**

These were alive a second time and died from be baptised in the lake of fire thrown alive.

The days coming burning like an oven.

Malachi 4:1 For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and **the day that cometh shall burn them up**, saith the Lord of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

Malachi 4:3 And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they **shall be ashes** under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do this, saith the LORD of hosts.

The baptism of fire will turn them to Ashes under the feet at the end of the 1000 years.

The wicked in the end will be turned back to ashes as man was told in the beginning.

This is what occurs before the new heaven and new earth is those who are thrown into the lake of fire will be turned to ashes.
