Exodus 17:11 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

Exodus 17:12 But Moses hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

Then Joshua killed them with the edge of the sword

Exodus 17:13 And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.

Then the people of God went into the promise land.

Now here is the Revelation of this foreshadow.

Two lead the people of God into the wilderness.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

The people of God go into the wilderness for the 42 months.

Rev 12:6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

At the end of the appointed time in the wilderness the Beasts armies come.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

These armies are gathered to be lead by Yeshua (Joshua) to defeat the armies of the Beast.

Yeshua was brought up to a mountain and His arms were lifted up.

Mark 15:22 And they bring him unto the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.



All Yeshuas armies who look upon Him will win in this battle just like the armies who looked upon Moses with his arms up won thier battle.

Zech 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and **they shall look upon me whom they have pierced**, and they **shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son**, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

Rev 19:21 And **the remnant were slain with the sword of him** that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.
