

Birds curse

The curse on Jerusalem for the end times is for Disobediance.

Deut 28:25 The Lord shall cause thee to be smitten before thine enemies: thou shalt go out one way against them, and flee seven ways before them: and shalt be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.

Deut 28:26 And **thy carcass shall be meat unto all fowls of the air**, and unto the beasts of the earth, and no man shall fray them away.

The foreshadows of the end times birds eating flesh are seen in the following scriptures.

Birds eating flesh during time of Elijah, Baasha getting cursed for desobediance.

1 kings 16:4 **Him that dieth** of Baasha in the city shall the dogs eat; and him that dieth of his in the fields shall **the fowls of the air eat**.

Birds eating flesh of Disobediant at the sacking of Jerusalem by Babylon.

Jeremiah 7:32 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be called Tophet, nor the valley of the son of Hinnom, but the valley of slaughter: for they shall bury in Tophet, till there be no place.

33 And **the carcasses of this people shall be meat for the fowls of the heaven**, and for the beasts of the earth; and none shall fray them away.

34 Then will I cause to cease from the cities of Judah, and from the streets of Jerusalem, the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride: for the land shall be desolate.

Birds eating flesh of all for Disobediance at Christ sacking of Jerusalem in the end.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the **fowls that fly in the midst of heaven**, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great.

Rev 19:21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and **all the fowls were filled with their flesh**.

This curse will be laid on all who disobey and fight the words spoken to them.

The prophesy will come to pass.
