

Bread and Water

The Exodus foreshadow the bread and water of the end times.

During the Exodus persecution from pharaoh in the wilderness they were fed bread and water.

Exodus 16:4 Then said the Lord unto Moses, Behold, I will rain **bread from heaven** for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or no.

Exodus 16:12 I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning **ye shall be filled with bread**; and ye shall know that I am the Lord your God.

Moses brings water from the Rock.

Exodus 17:6 Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall **come water out of it**, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

Children of Israel fed flesh bread and water in the wilderness in fleeing from face of pharaoh.

Days of Elijah also foreshadowed the end of time wilderness Exodus.

During the time of the image of baal and persecution of Gods people.

The people of God during persecution were hidden in the wilderness and fed bread and water.

Elijah sent to the wilderness during no rain and famine fed flesh bread and water.

1 kings 17:3 Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan.

4 And it shall be, that thou **shalt drink of the brook**; and I have commanded the ravens to feed thee there.

5 So he went and did according unto the word of the Lord: for he went and dwelt by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan.

6 And the ravens **brought him bread** and flesh in the morning, **and bread** and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook.

Elijah was given bread and water.

Obediah hid the prophets in caves of the mountains feeding them bread and water during famine when they were being persecuted.

1 kings 18:4 For it was so, when **Jezebel cut off the prophets** of the Lord, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and hid them by fifty **in a cave**, and fed them with **bread and water.**)

The WOMAN then fed Elijah with bread and water

1 Kings 17:10 So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, behold, the widow **woman** was there gathering of sticks: and he called to her, and said, Fetch me, I pray thee, **a little water** in a vessel, that I may drink.

11 And as she was going to fetch it, he called to her, and said, Bring me, I pray thee, **a morsel of bread** in thine hand.

Because the woman listened to the prophet. She was given Bread and Water during the 3.5 years.

1 kings 17:14 For thus saith the Lord God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, **until the day that the Lord sendeth rain upon the earth.**

15 And she went and did according to the saying of Elijah: and she, and he, and her house, did eat many days.

16 And the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail, according to the word of the Lord, which he spake by Elijah.

When Elijah was persecuted fled he hid in the cave of wilderness and was fed with bread and water.

1 Kings 19:4 But he himself went a day's journey **into the wilderness**, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O Lord, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers.

Elijah was fed with bread and water.

1 kings 19:5 And as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, then an angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise and eat.

6 And he looked, and, behold, there was a **cake baken on the coals**, and a **cruse of water** at his head. And he did eat and drink, and laid him down again.

During the time of the Image of the Beast an persecution of Gods people into the wilderness.

Rev 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as **would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.**

The flight to the wilderness to be fed for 1260 days or 3.5 years, the same as during Elijah. The Woman who listens to the prophet will be fed with bread and water in the end just the same.

Rev 12:6 And **the woman fled into the wilderness**, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should **feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.**

Nourished with bread and water for the time and times and half of time during the persecution.

Rev 12:14 And to **the woman** were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly **into the wilderness**, into her place, where **she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time**, from the face of the serpent.

The bread is promised and a white stone with name written on it.

Rev 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will **I give to eat of the hidden manna**, and will give him a **white stone**, and in the **stone a new name written**, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.



This is all the foreshadow of the Exodus of the end times with Gods people who is the Woman.

The restored Israel of God with Jew and Gentile together as the Kingdom of God in the wilderness.

Here is the banner with the white stone to lead the remnant to the wilderness to be fed manna.

The account of Moses and Elijah both testify of the bread and water which is the law and prophets.
