

Mighty wind

The days of Elijah foreshadow the end times events and the day of the Lord.

1 Kings 17:1 And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the Lord God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there **shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.**

This was 3.5 years or 1260 days.

The bible tells us this is the 3.5 years or 1260 days no rain.

James 5:17 **Elias** was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and **it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.**

18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

At the end of the 1260 days of no rain, during the time of Elijah of the 3.5 years of no rain, the sky went black, clouds appeared and wind and rain came.

1 kings 18:41 And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for there is a sound of abundance of rain.

1 kings 18:45 And it came to pass in the mean while, that **the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain.** And Ahab rode, and went to Jezreel.

The end times prophesy of the 1260 days.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a **thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

1260 days.

Rev 11:6 These have power to **shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy:** and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

No rain 1260 days or 3.5 years.

At the end of the 1260 days the heavens turn black with a mighty wind.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the **sun became black** as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a **mighty wind.**

At the end of the 1260 days there is a great mighty wind of the Spirit in the Resurrection.

Rev 11:11 And after **three days and an half the spirit of life** from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

The cloud of the Son of Man appears in the darkness in heaven.

Rev 14:14 And **I looked, and behold a white cloud**, and **upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man**, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

Then the Rain of fire and brimstone comes own on the earth.

Rev 16:21 And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

At the end of the 1260 days, the heavens become black, the cloud is seen, the mighty wind comes and the rain comes.

as the days of Elijah so will it be at the coming of the Son of Man.
