Matt 3:4 And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins;
and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

The Church will be in the wilderness of petra in the end after fleeing judea.

Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet,
standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in **Judaea flee to the mountains:**

The place God has prepared in the wilderness for the 1260 days where they are fed..

Rev 12:6 And the **woman fled into the wilderness**, where **she hath a place** prepared of God, that
they should **feed her there** a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

She will be clothed with sackclothe in Camel hair beduin tents at petra.

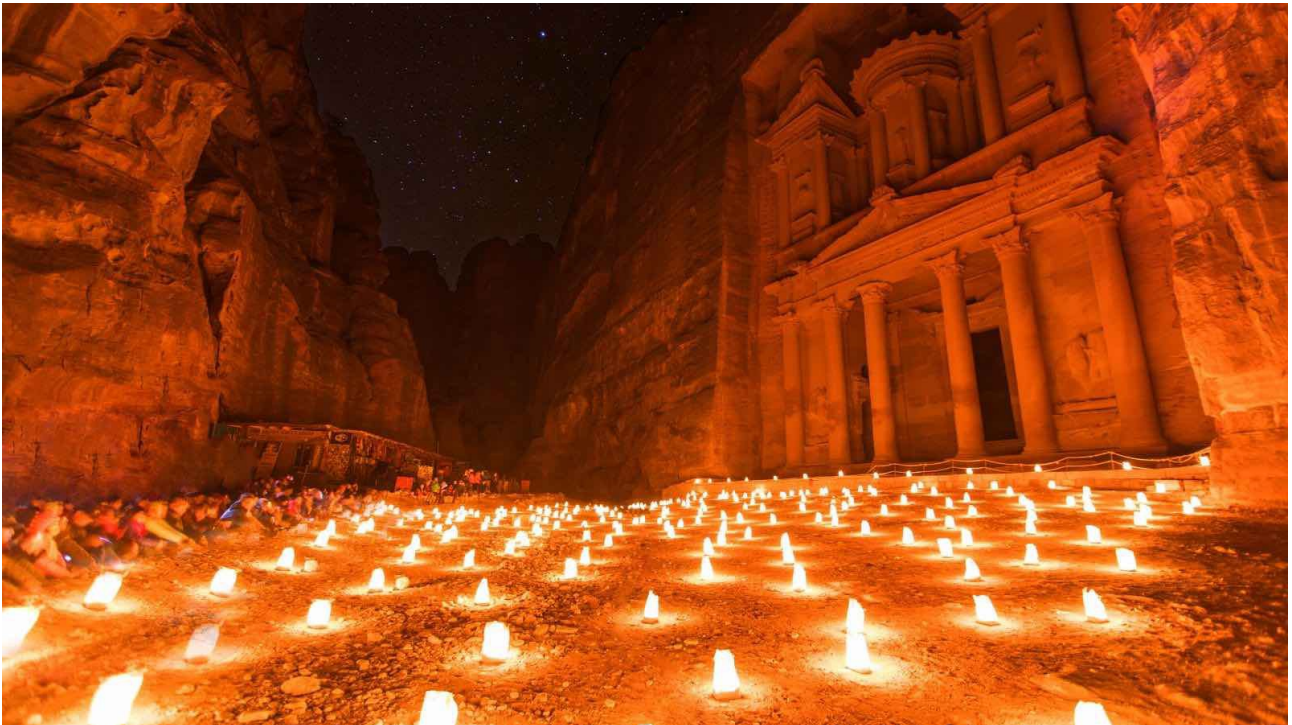


At petra there will be no electric grid and the people will use bees wax candles and eat the honey.

Rev 22:5 And there shall be no night there; and **they need no candle, neither light of the sun;** for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and **the sun became black as sackcloth of hair,** and the moon became as blood;

John the Baptist wore the camel hair and ate locust and honey as a sign of the Church in the end.
