

The Woman Jezebel and her seed and the Faithful Woman and her seed.

The Church is warned about Jezebel and her seed.

Rev 2:18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass;

Rev 2:20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Jezebel was teaching people to break the commandments of God.

Rev 2:21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

Rev 2:22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and **them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation**, except they repent of their deeds.

Those who follow Jezebel are her children. They will be put into the great tribulation of 1260 days.

Rev 2:23 And **I will kill her children with death**; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

Her children are her seed who are following her teachings in the Church. They will be put to death.

Jezebel the disobedient woman and her seed who are killed from the church in the great tribulation.

We see the likeness of the faithful in the Woman of Revelation 12 during the great tribulation.

This woman flees when seeing the image of the beast the idol set up in Jerusalem.

Mark 13:14 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:

here is the idol being set up and the woman fleeing to the wilderness mountains for the 1260 days of the great tribulation.

Revelation 12:6 And **the woman fled into the wilderness**, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a **thousand two hundred and threescore days**.

Here is the woman's seed who is keeping the commandments of God and testimony of Jesus Christ.

The woman's children are her seed.

Rev 12:17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of **her seed**, which **keep the commandments of God**, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

The comparison is between the Children of Jezebel who do not keep the commandments of God who are put into the great tribulation to kill them.

The woman and her seed who keep the commandments of God who are spared in great tribulation.
